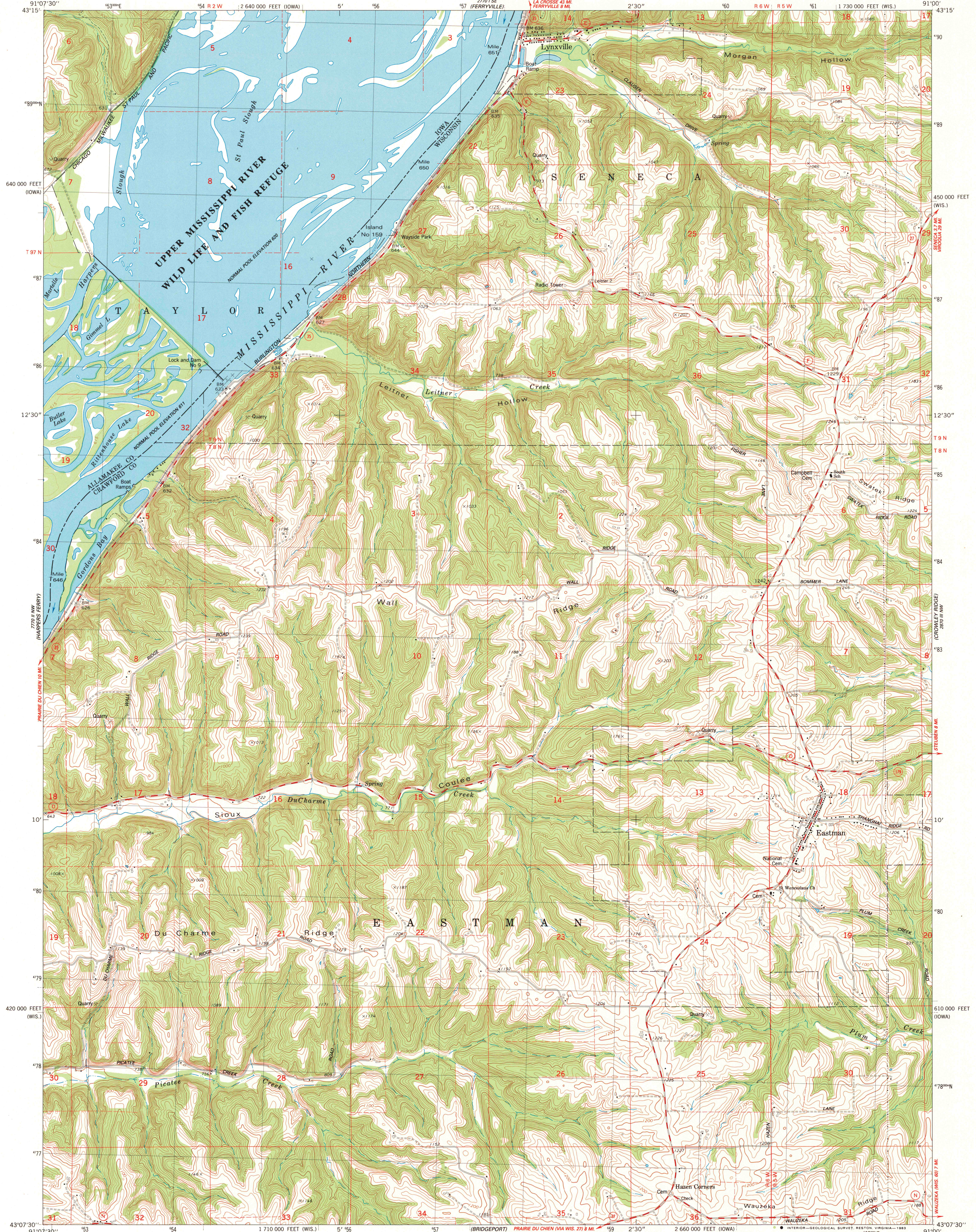
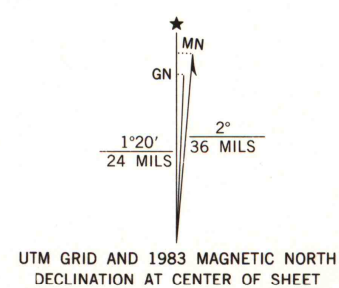

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 5 meters north and 12 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks. There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map.
