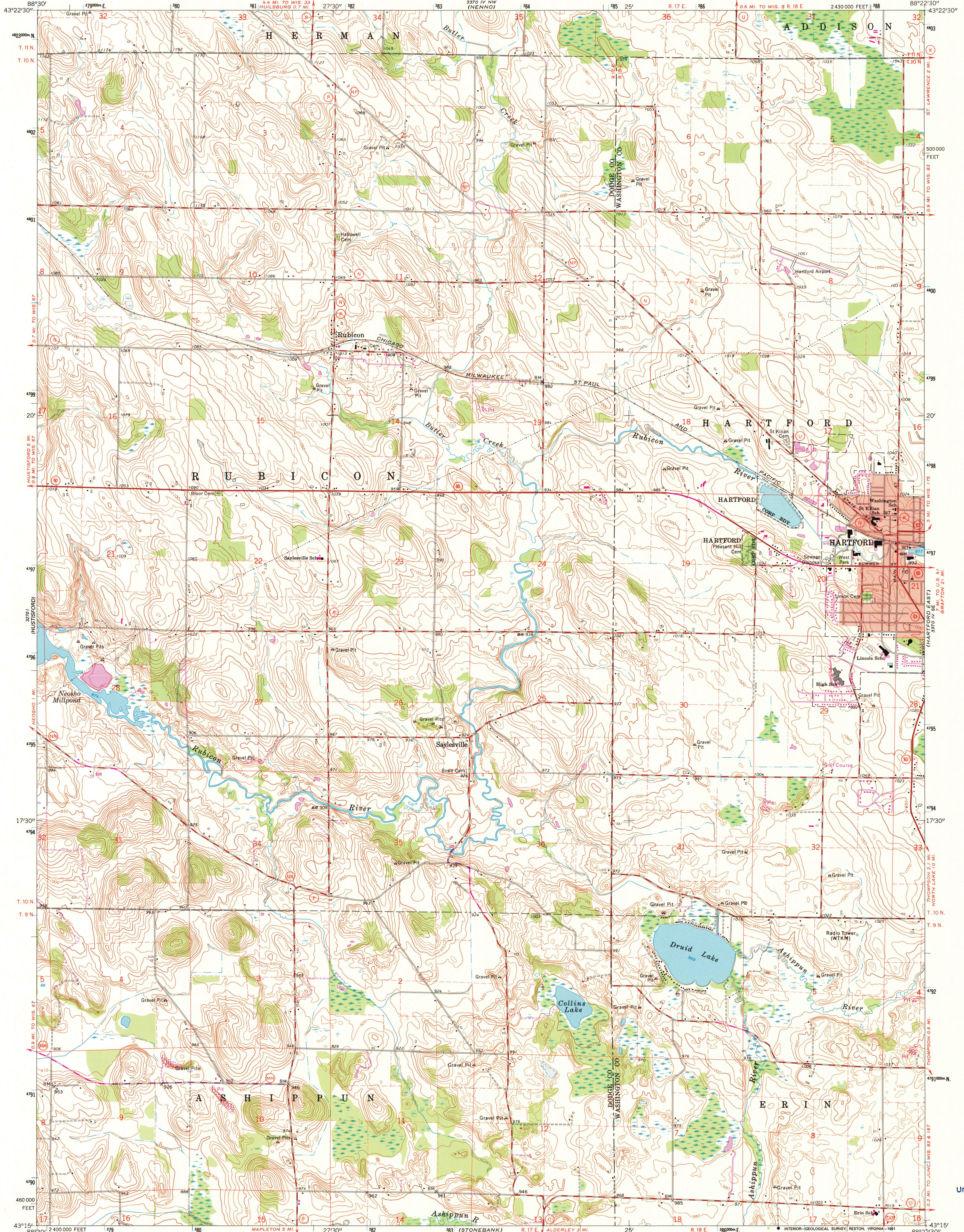

SW/4 HARTFORD 15' QUADRANGLE

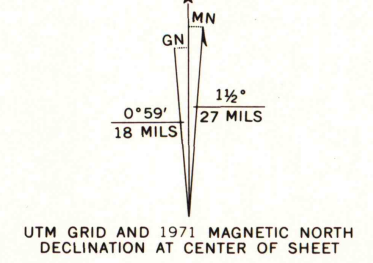

generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked

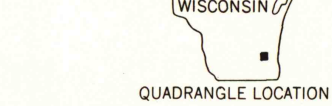
