

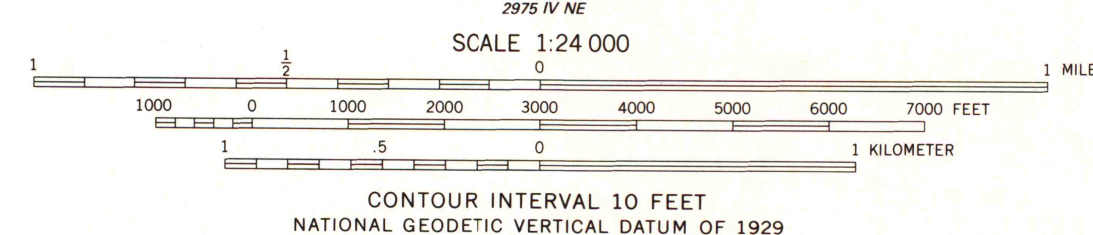

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983, move the projection lines 6 meters north and 11 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks. There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map.
