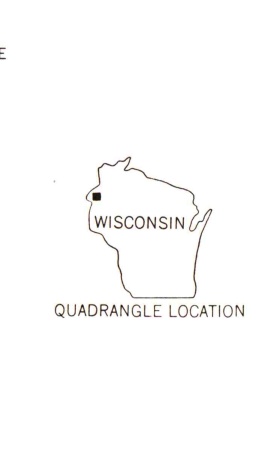

Hydrography compiled from information furnished by Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources. Projection and 10,000-foot grid ticks: Wisconsin coordinate system, north zone (Lambert conformal conic). 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid, zone 15. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 8 meters north and 14 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks. There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map. Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked.
