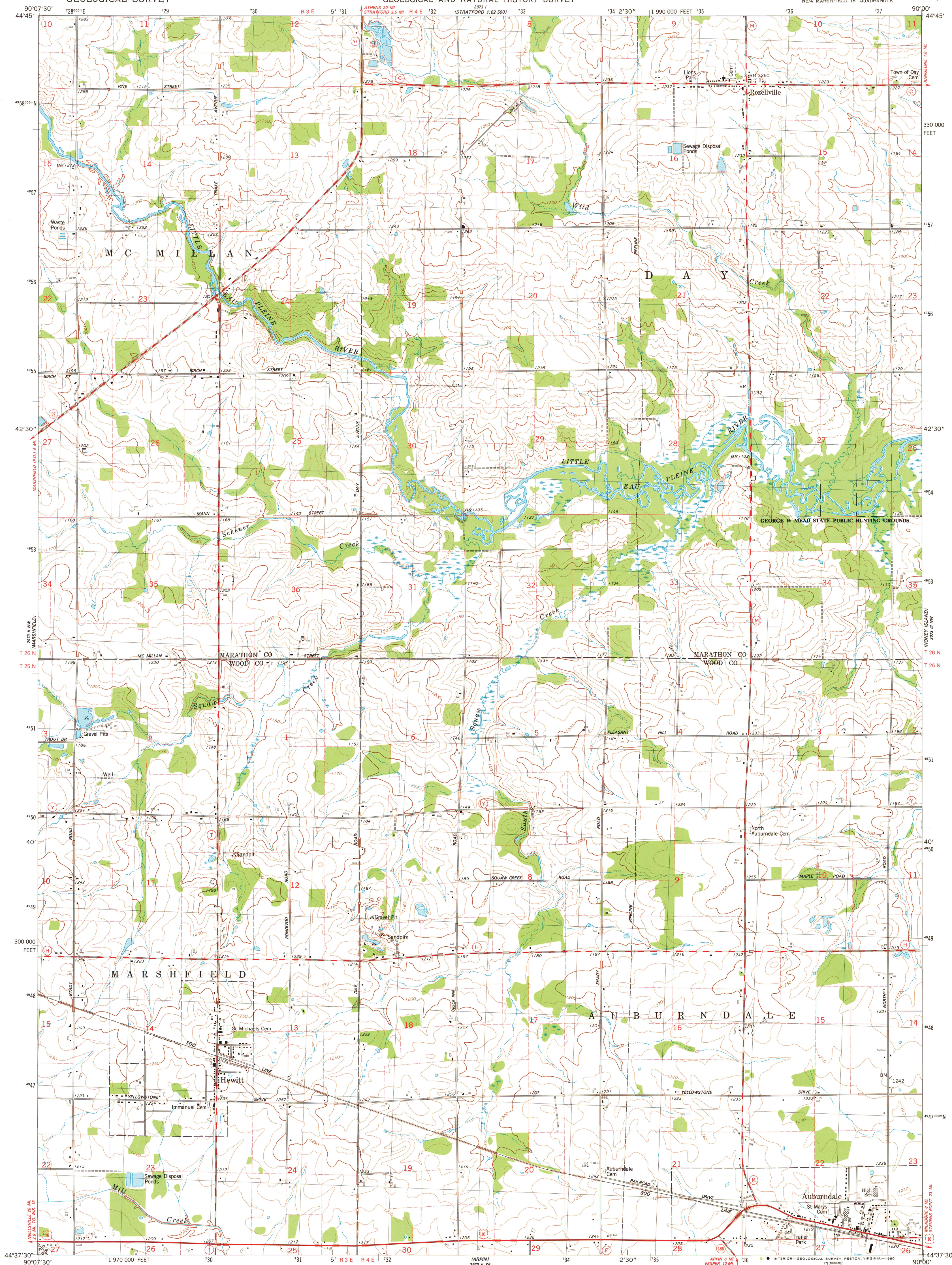

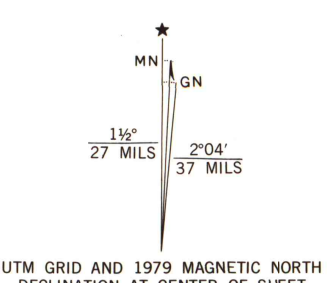

Maped, edited, and published by the Geological Survey in cooperation with the Wisconsin Division of Highways and Wisconsin Geological and Natural History Survey. Control by USGS and NOS/NOAA.

Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1976. Field checked 1977. Map edited 1979. Projection and 10,000-foot grid ticks: Wisconsin coordinate system, central zone (Lambert conformal conic). 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid, zone 15 1927 North American datum. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 6 meters north and 11 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks. There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map.
