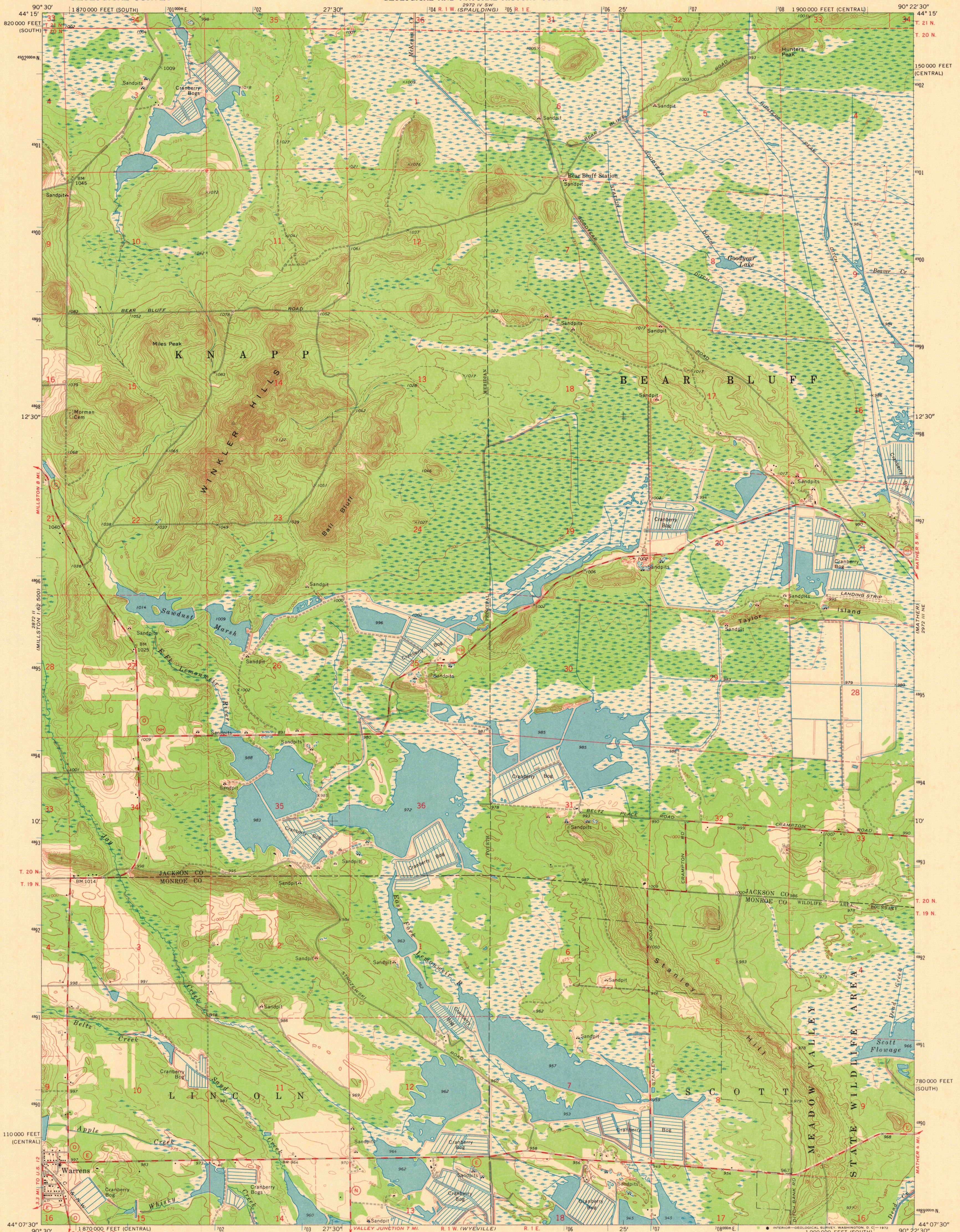

NW 1/4 WYEVILLE 15' QUADRANGLE



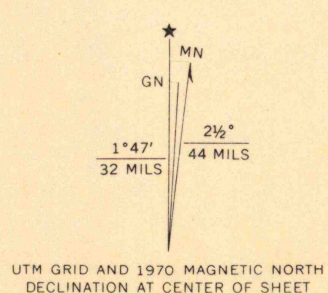
