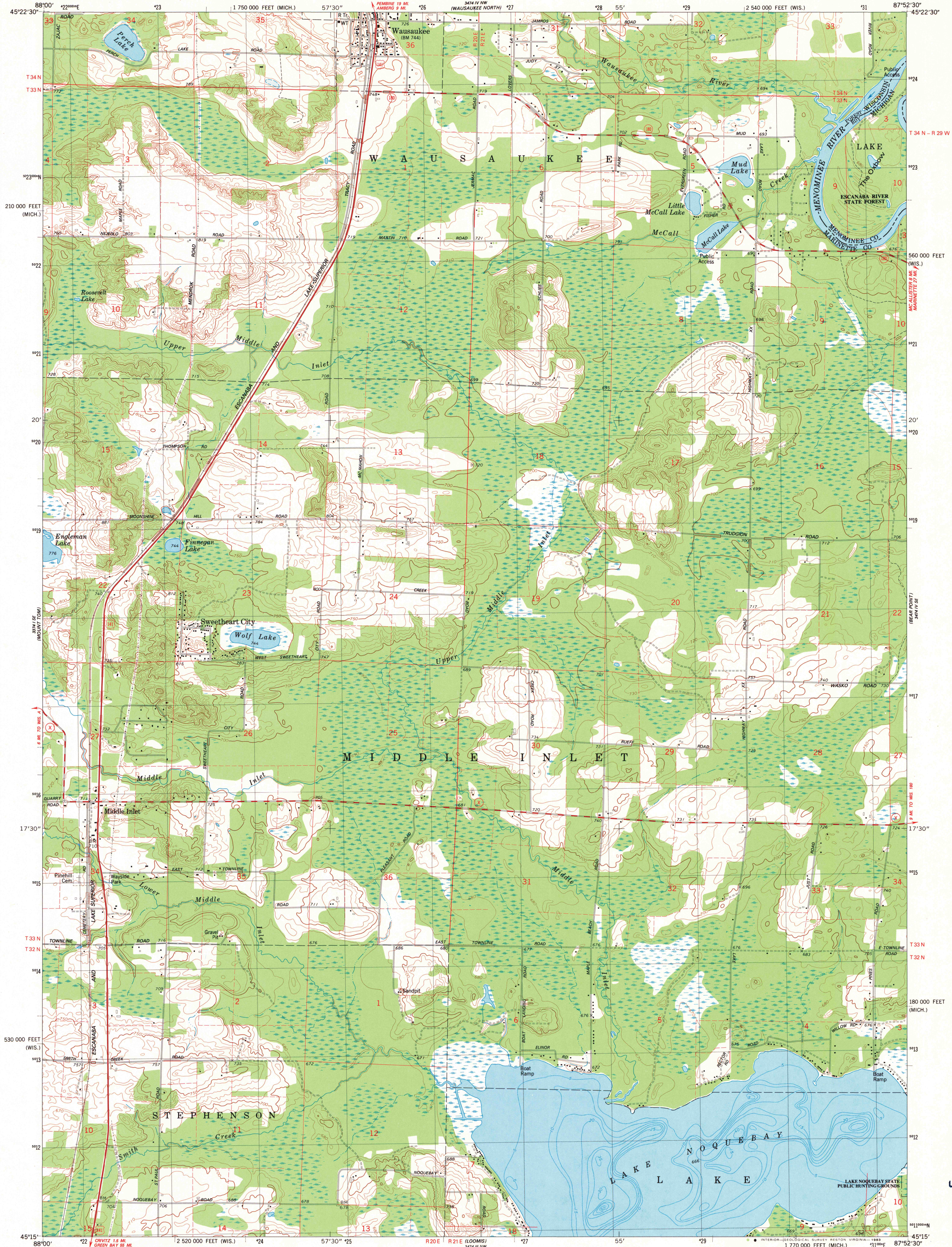

Projection: Wisconsin coordinate system, central zone (Lambert conformal conic). 10,000-foot grid ticks based on Wisconsin coordinate system, central zone and Michigan coordinate system, north zone 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid, zone 16 1927 North American Datum. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 6 meters north and 7 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks. There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map.
