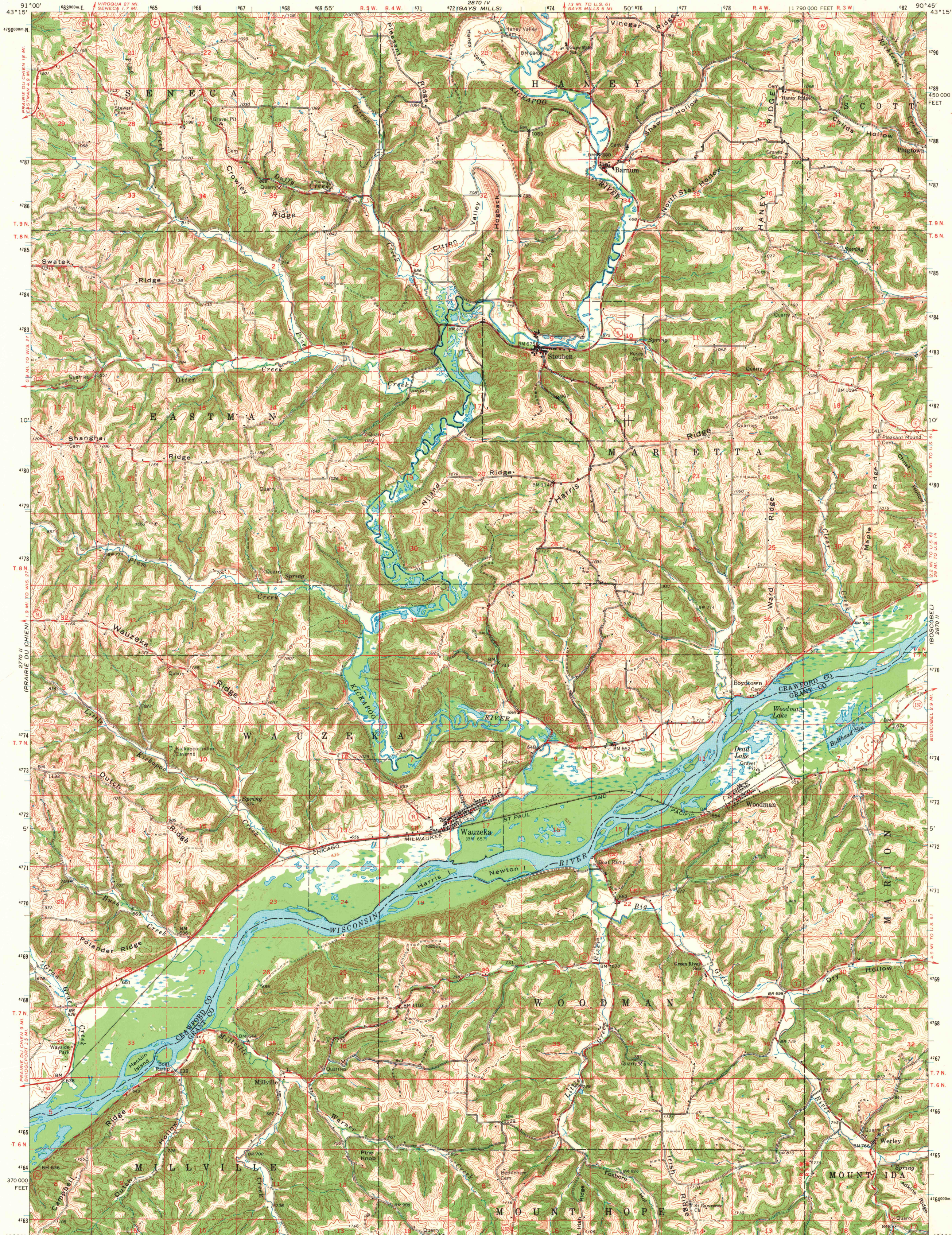

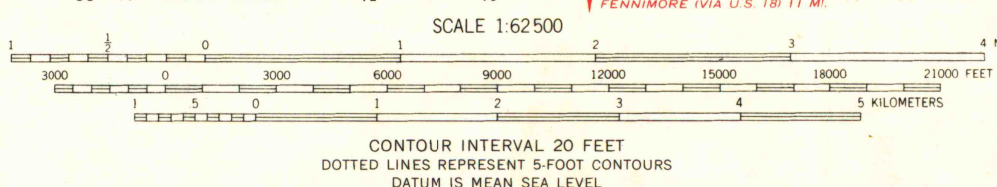
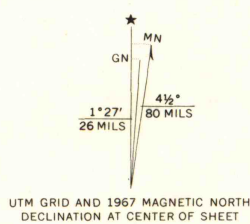
WAUZEKA QUADRANGLE
