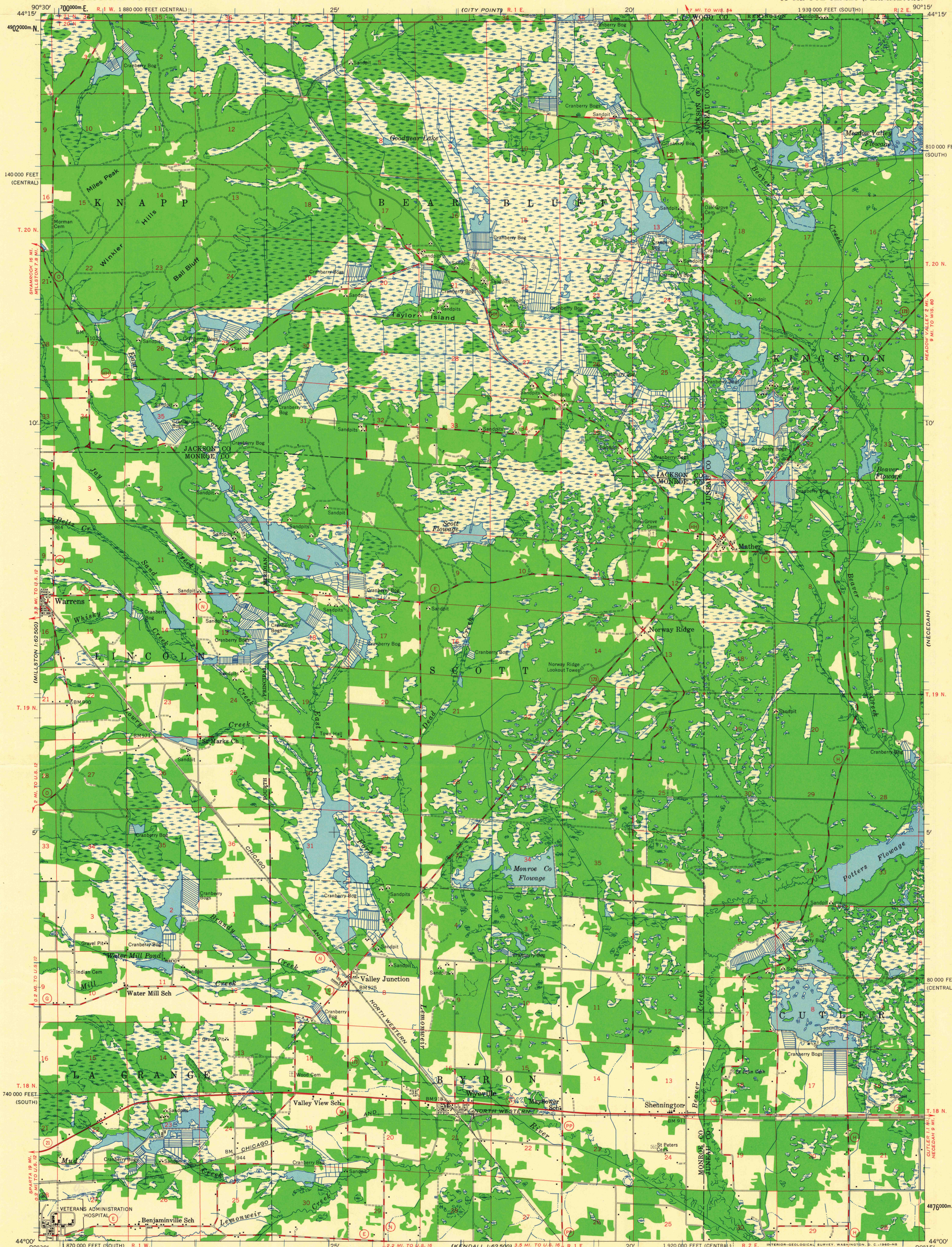

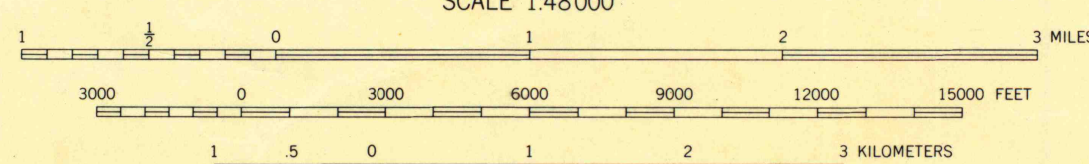

10,000-foot grids based on Wisconsin coordinate system, south and central zones

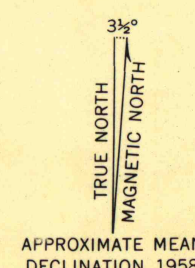
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 15, shown in blue
