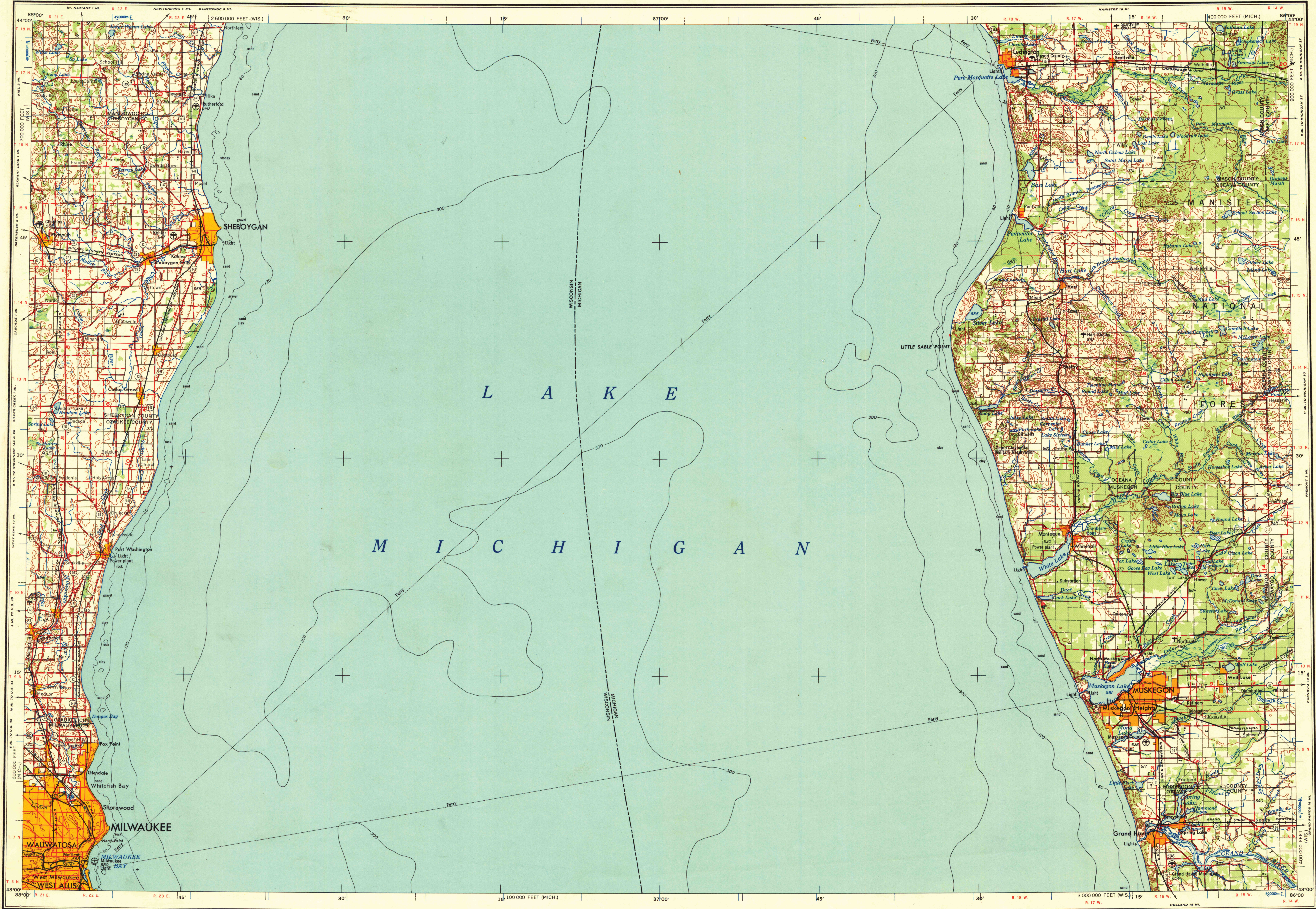
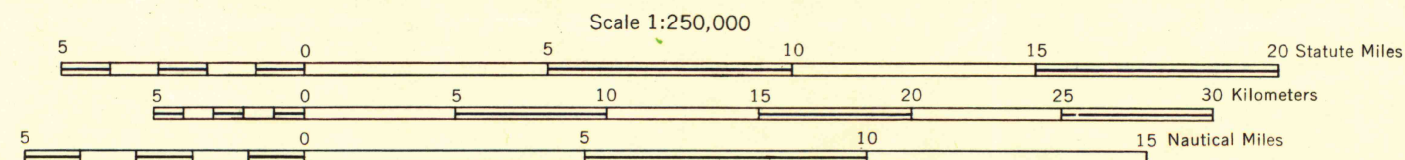
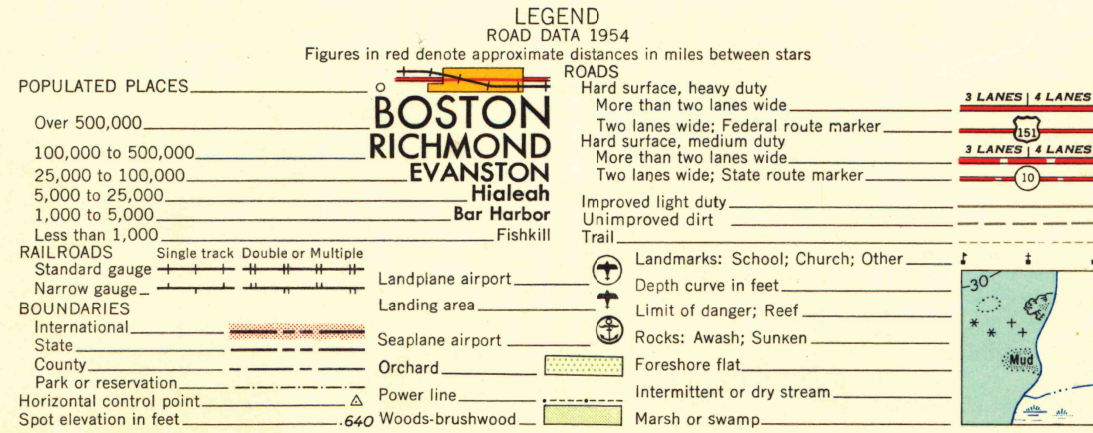

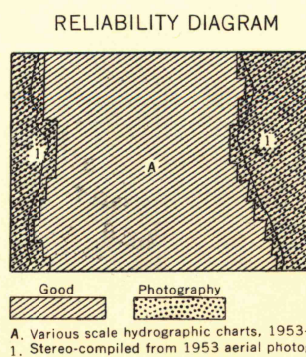
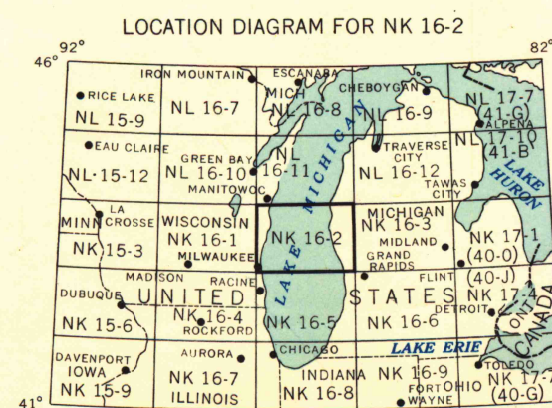
100,000-foot grids based on Michigan coordinate system, central zone and Wisconsin coordinate system, south zone.
