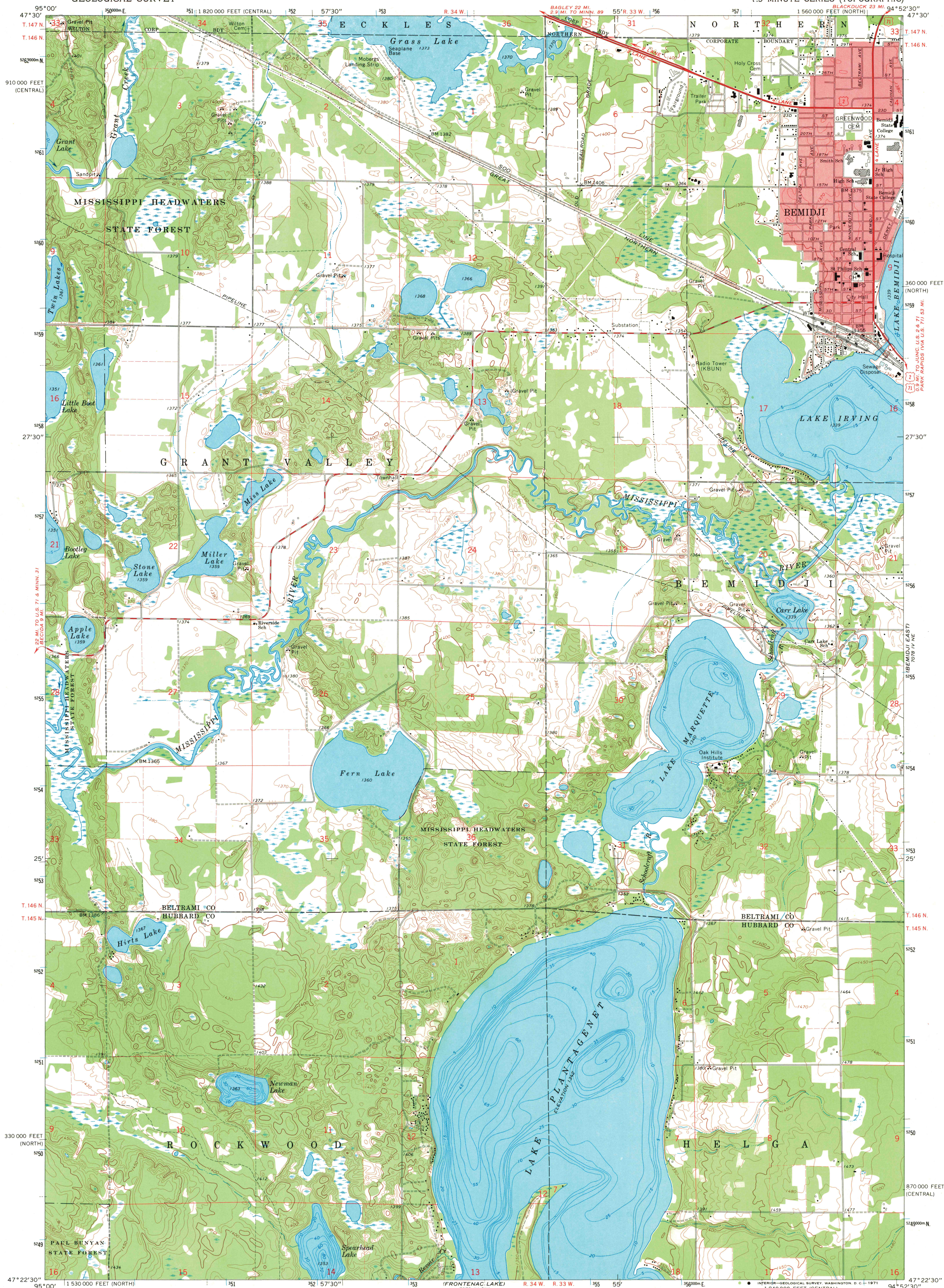
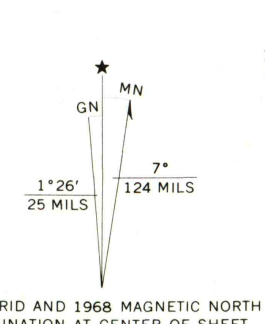

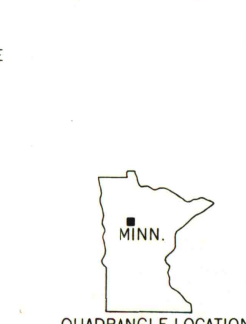
BEMIDJI WEST QUADRANGLE
