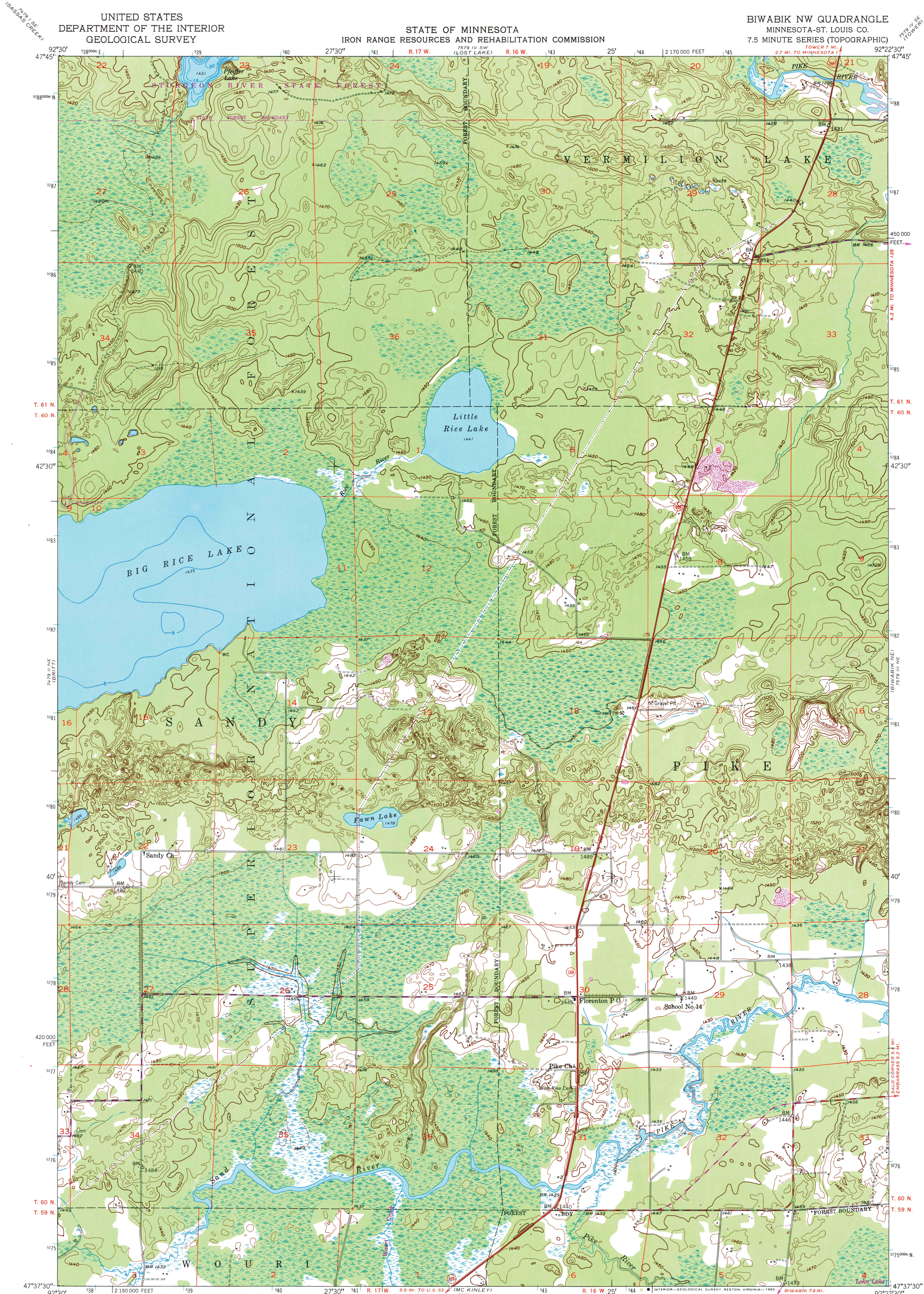

Depth curves and soundings compiled from charts furnished by Minnesota Department of Conservation

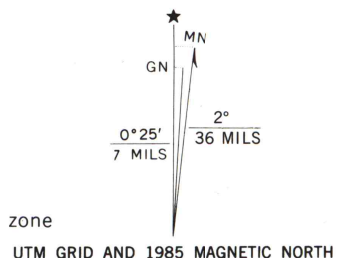
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American Datum

10,000-foot grid based on Minnesota coordinate system, north zone

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 15, shown in blue

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 6 meters north and 14 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

There may be private inholdings within the boundaries
