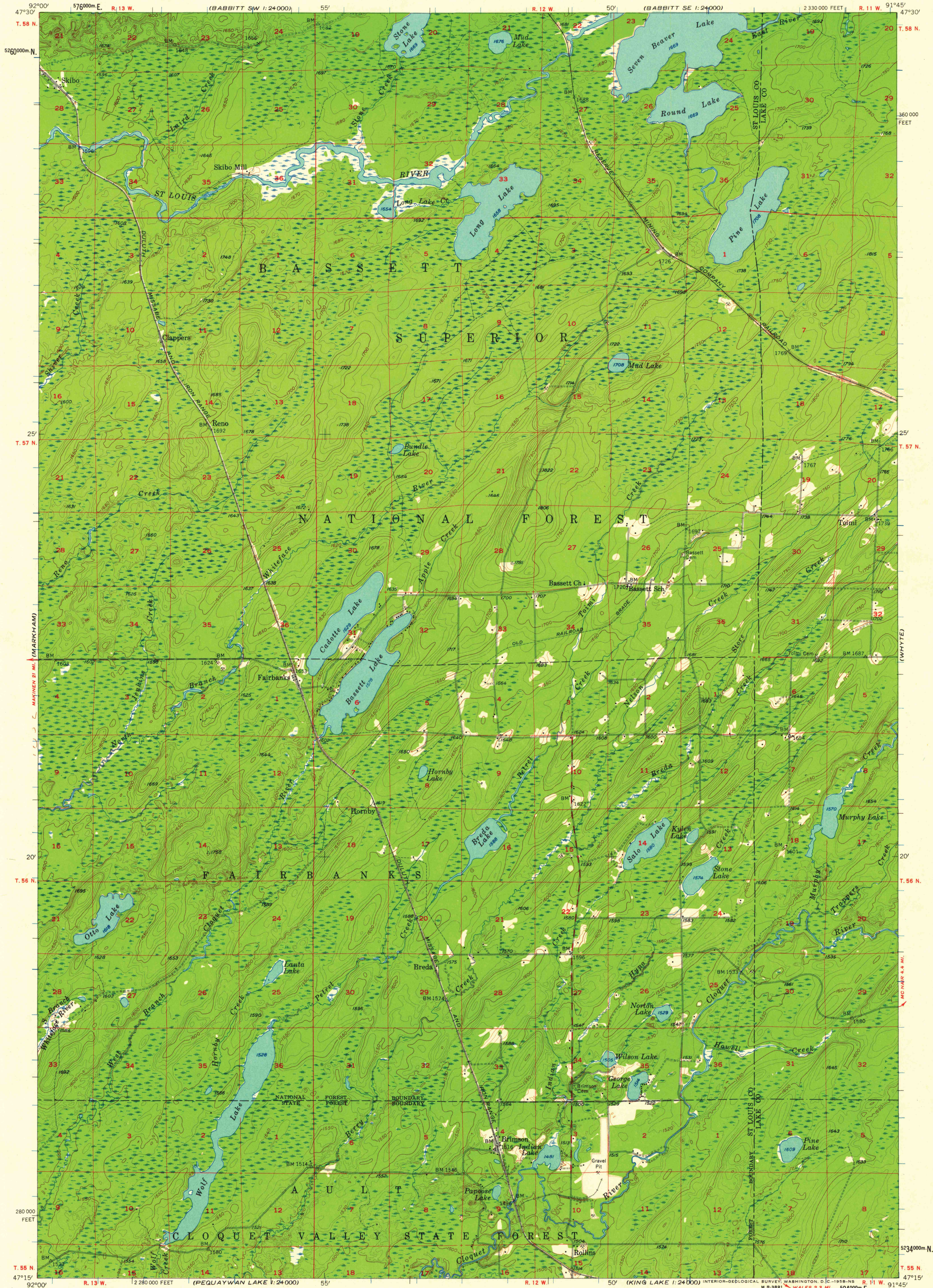

Topography from aerial photographs by Kelsh plotter and by planetable surveys 1957. Aerial photographs taken 1953-1954

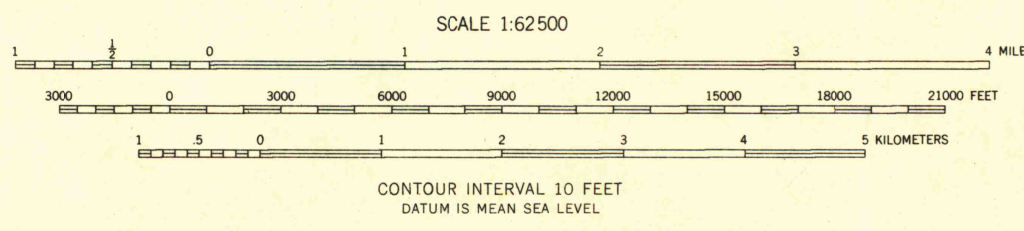
Polycyclic projection. 1927 North American datum
