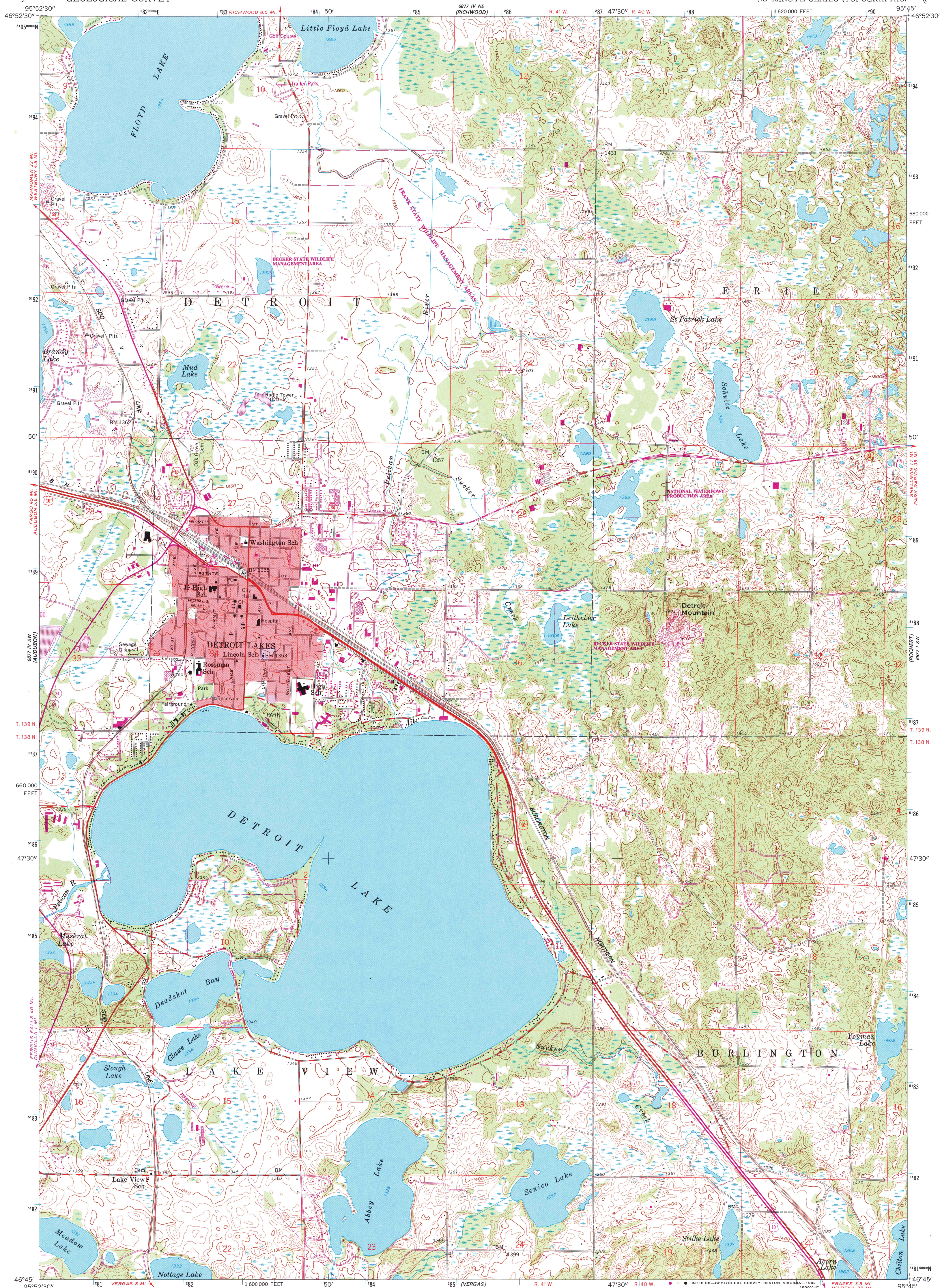

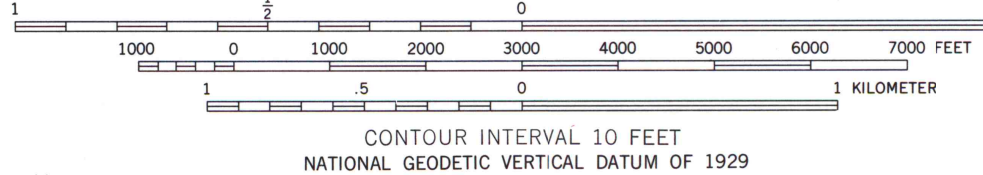
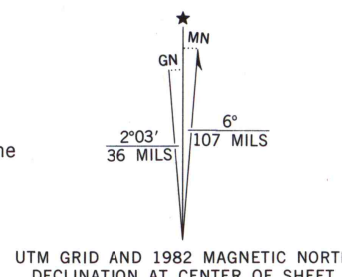
Aerial photographs taken 1957. Field check 1959
