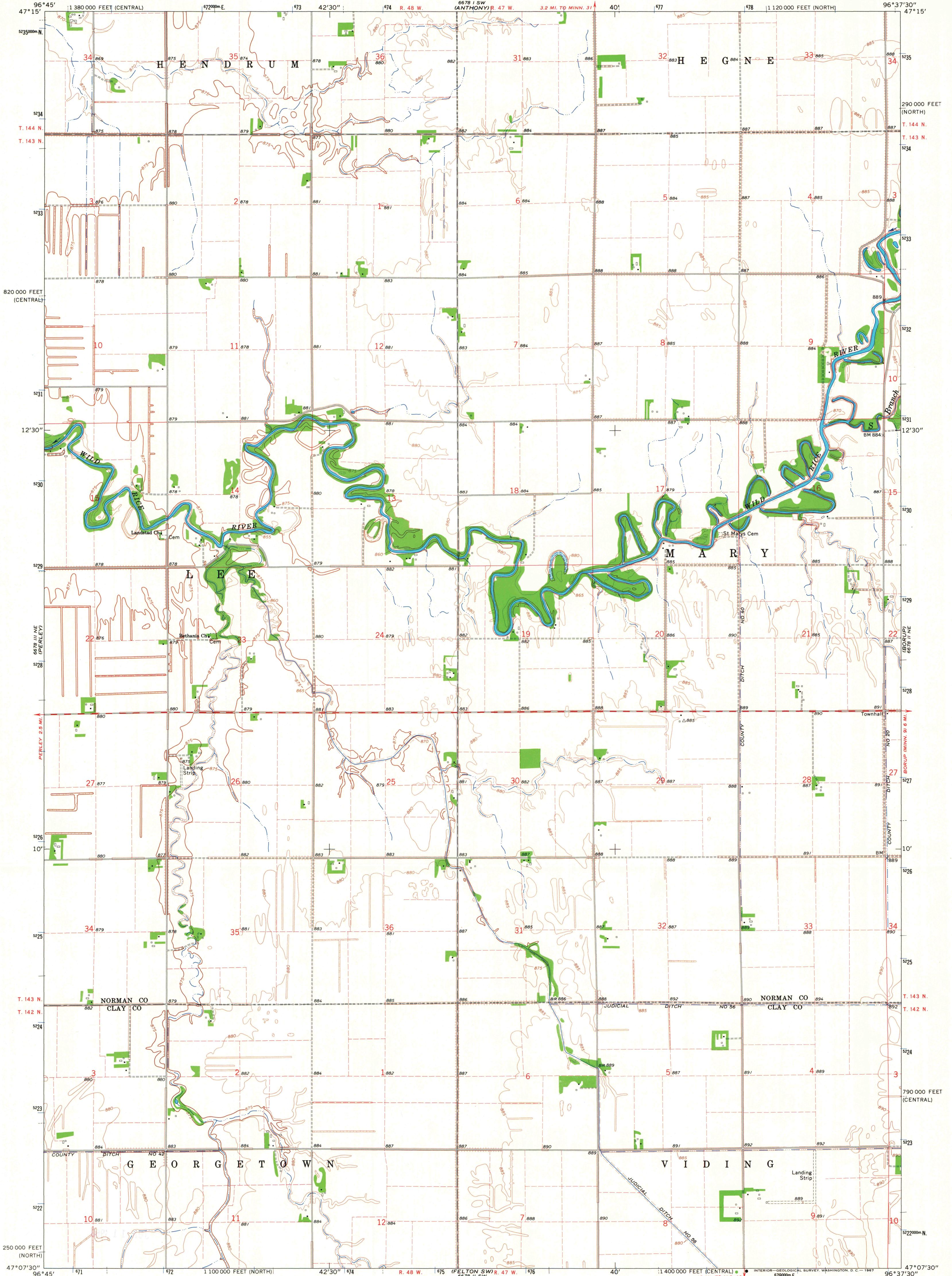

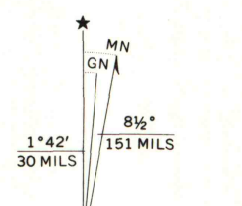
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines

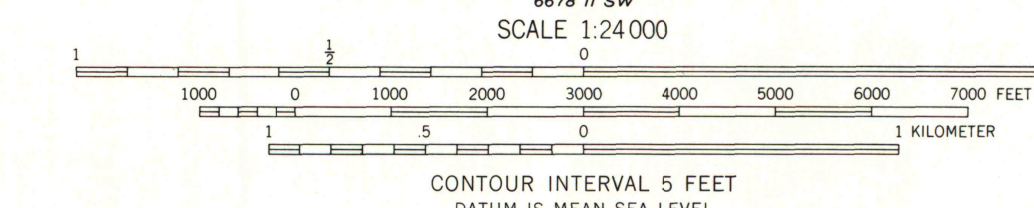
