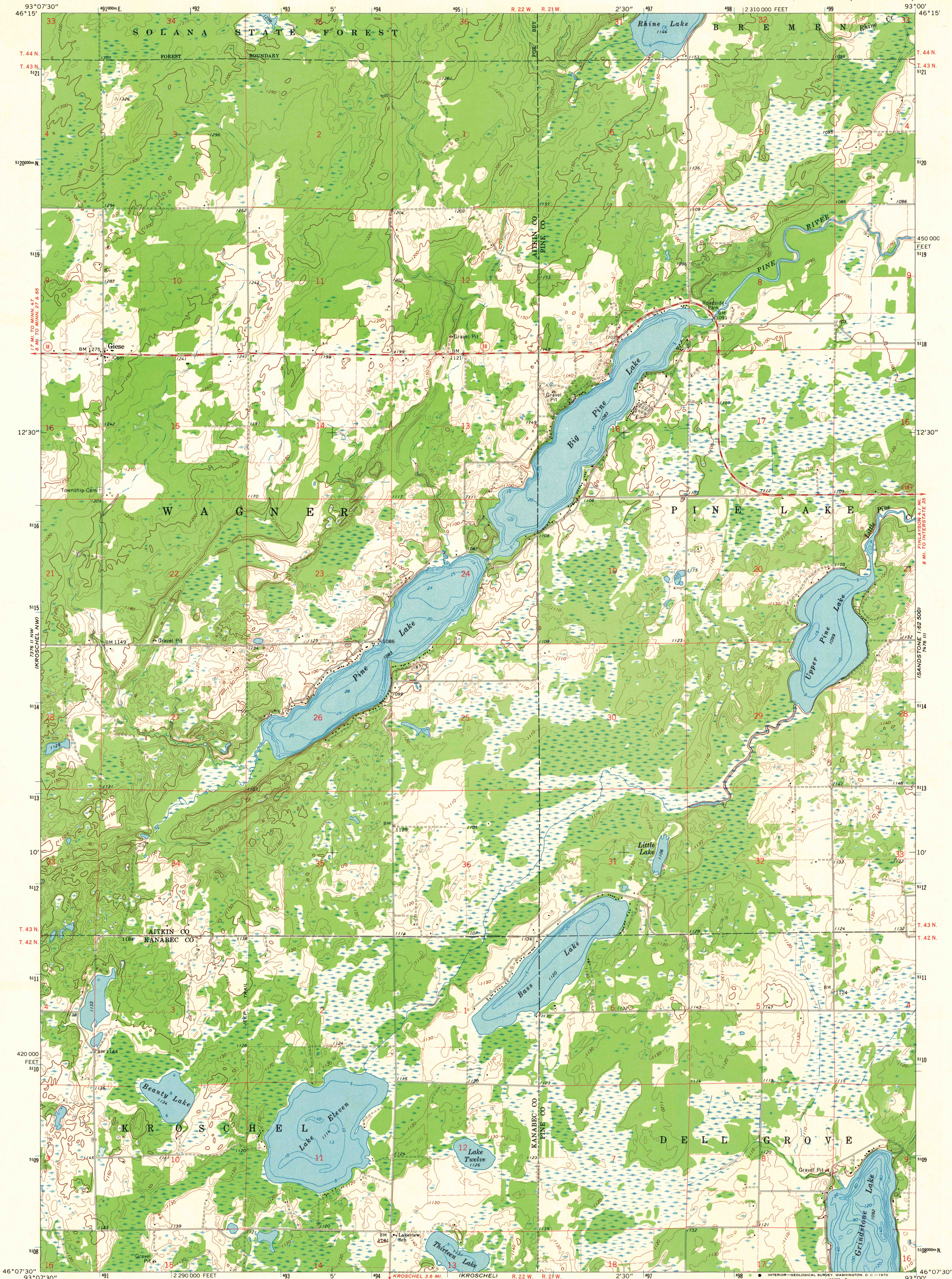

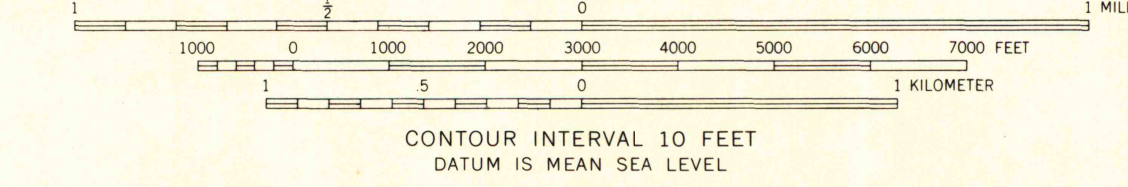
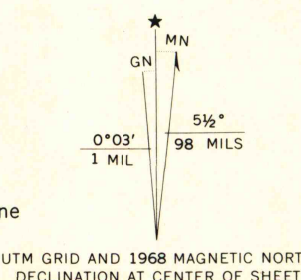
Depth curves and soundings compiled from charts furnished by Minnesota Department of Conservation
