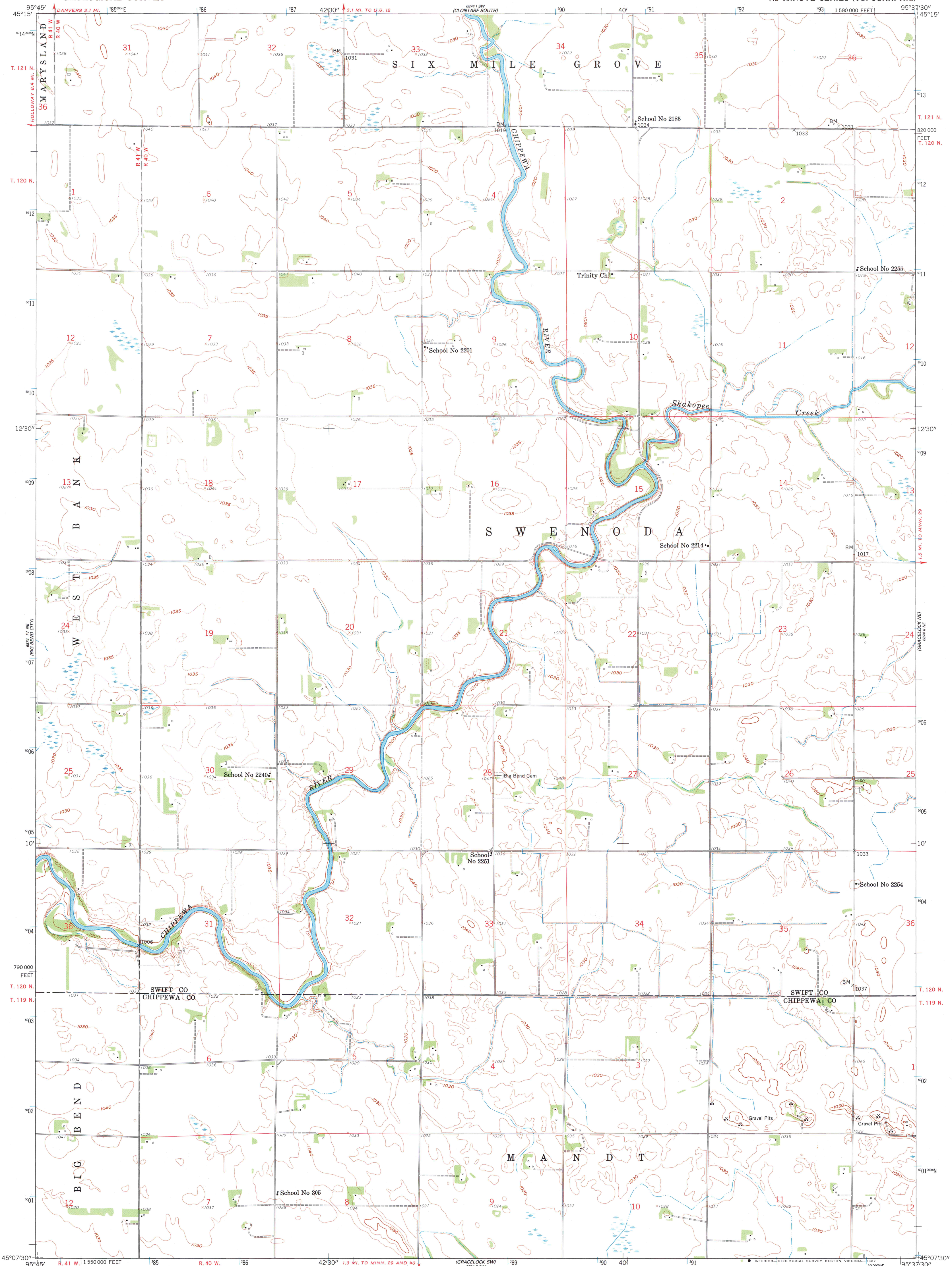

10,000-foot grid based on Minnesota coordinate system, south zone

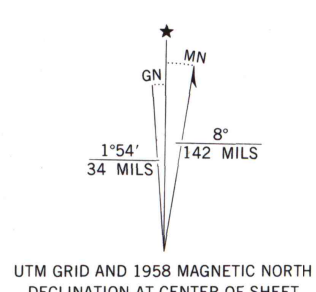
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 15, shown in blue
