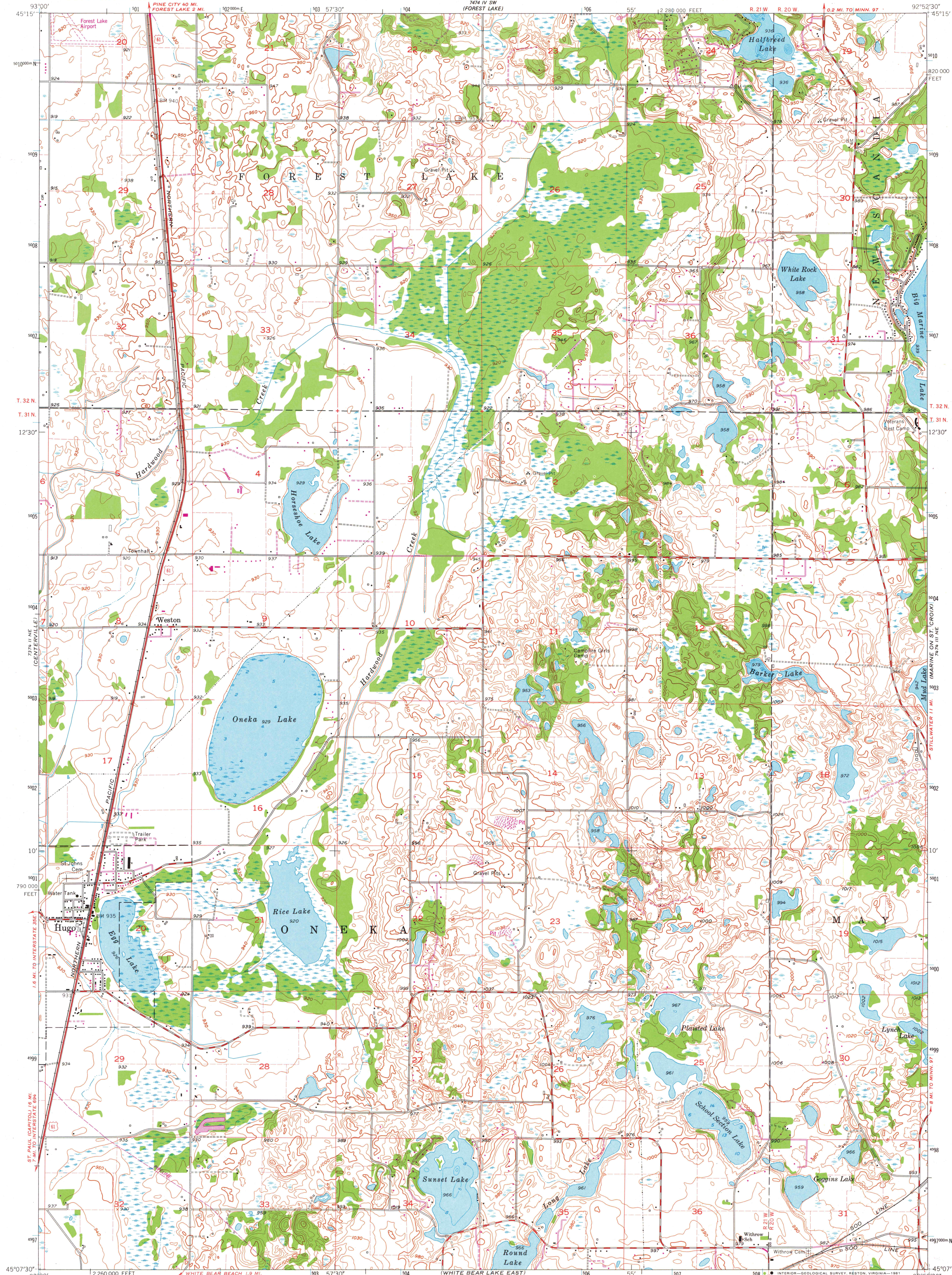




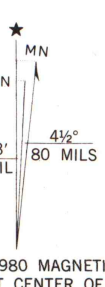

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grid based on Minnesota coordinate system, south zone 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 15, shown in blue. To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 7 meters north and 16 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks.
