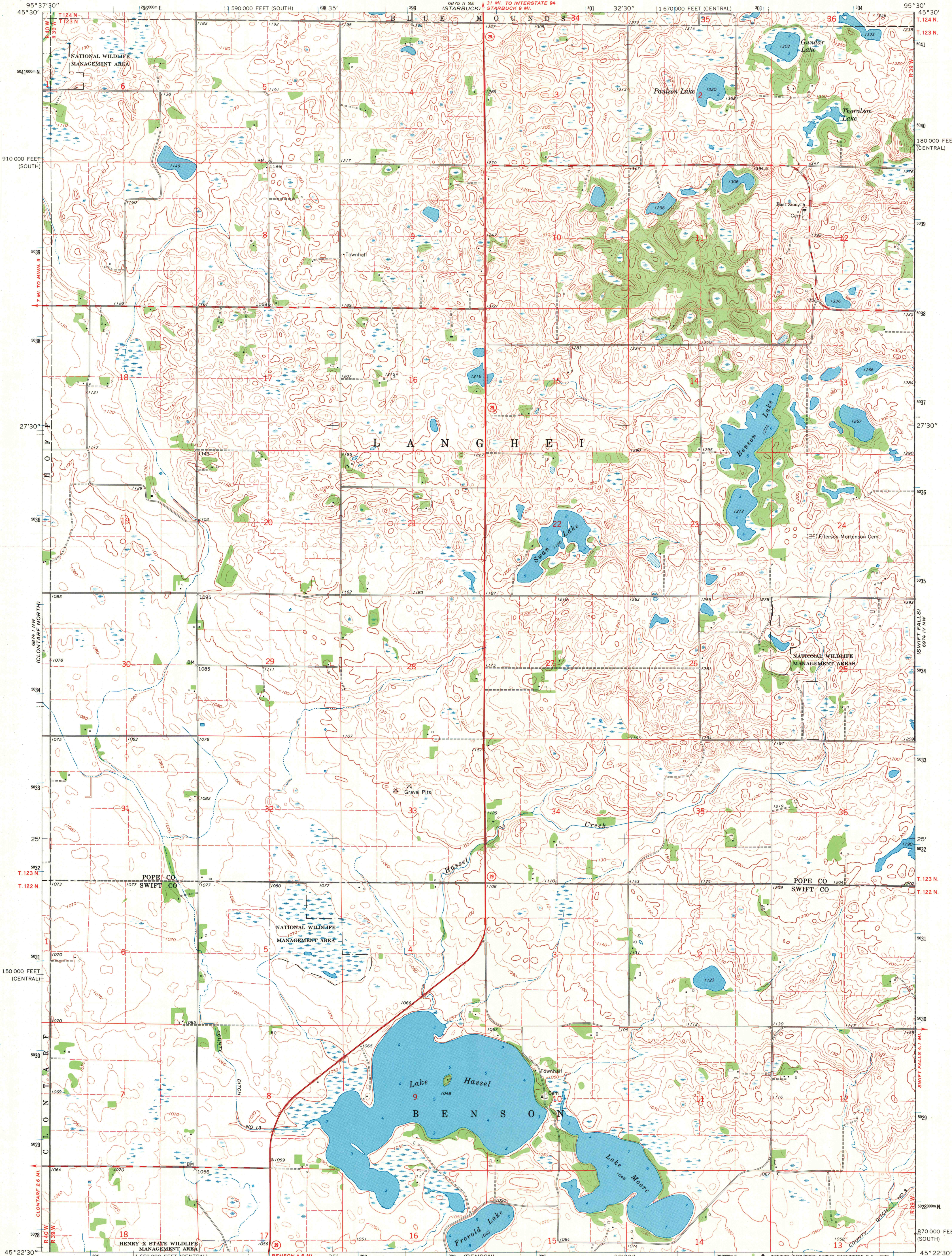

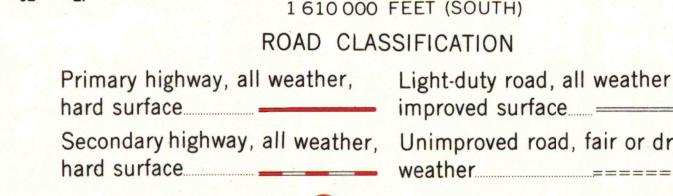
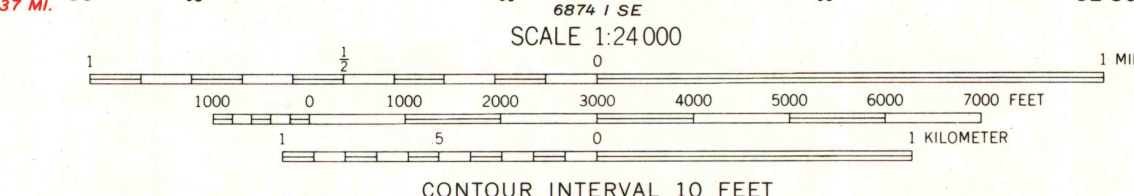
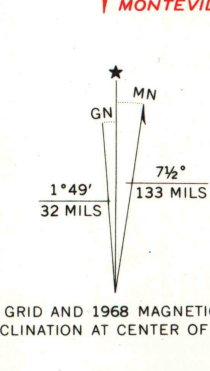
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum

10,000-foot grids based on Minnesota coordinate system, central and south zones

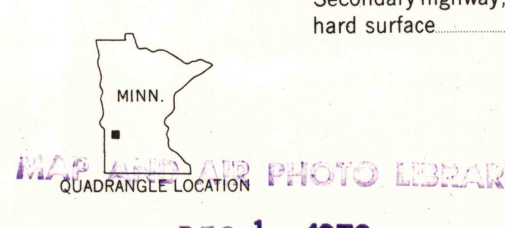
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 15, shown in blue
