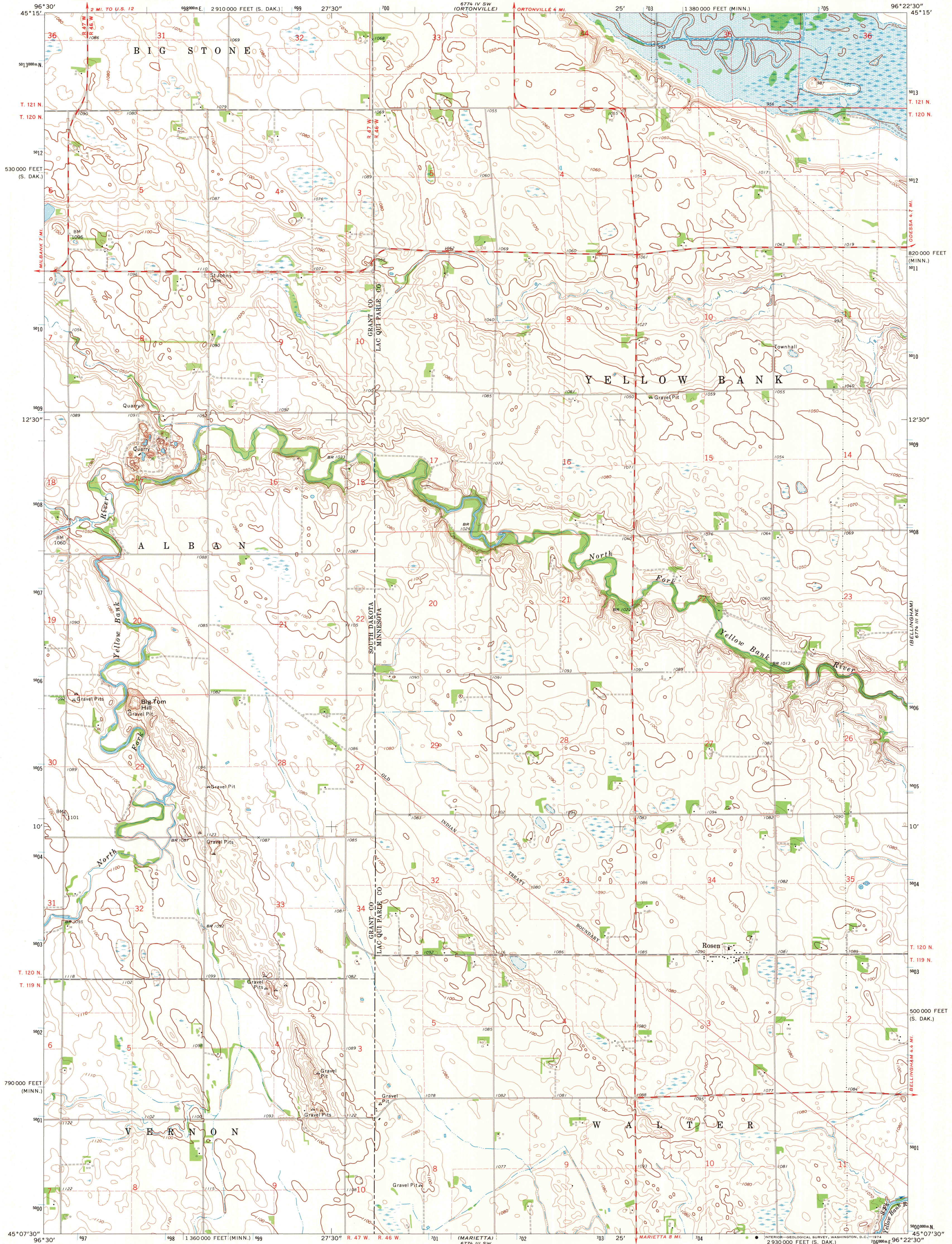

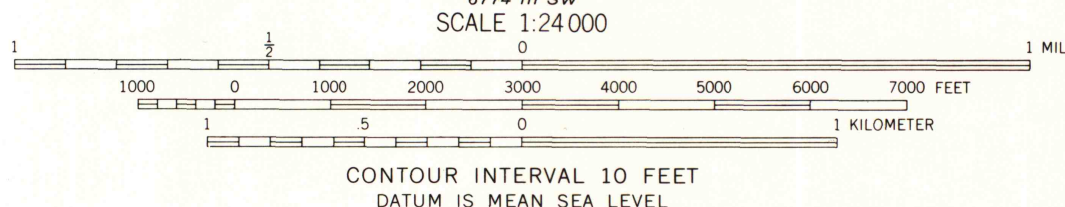
Projection: Minnesota coordinate system, south zone (Lambert conformal conic)
