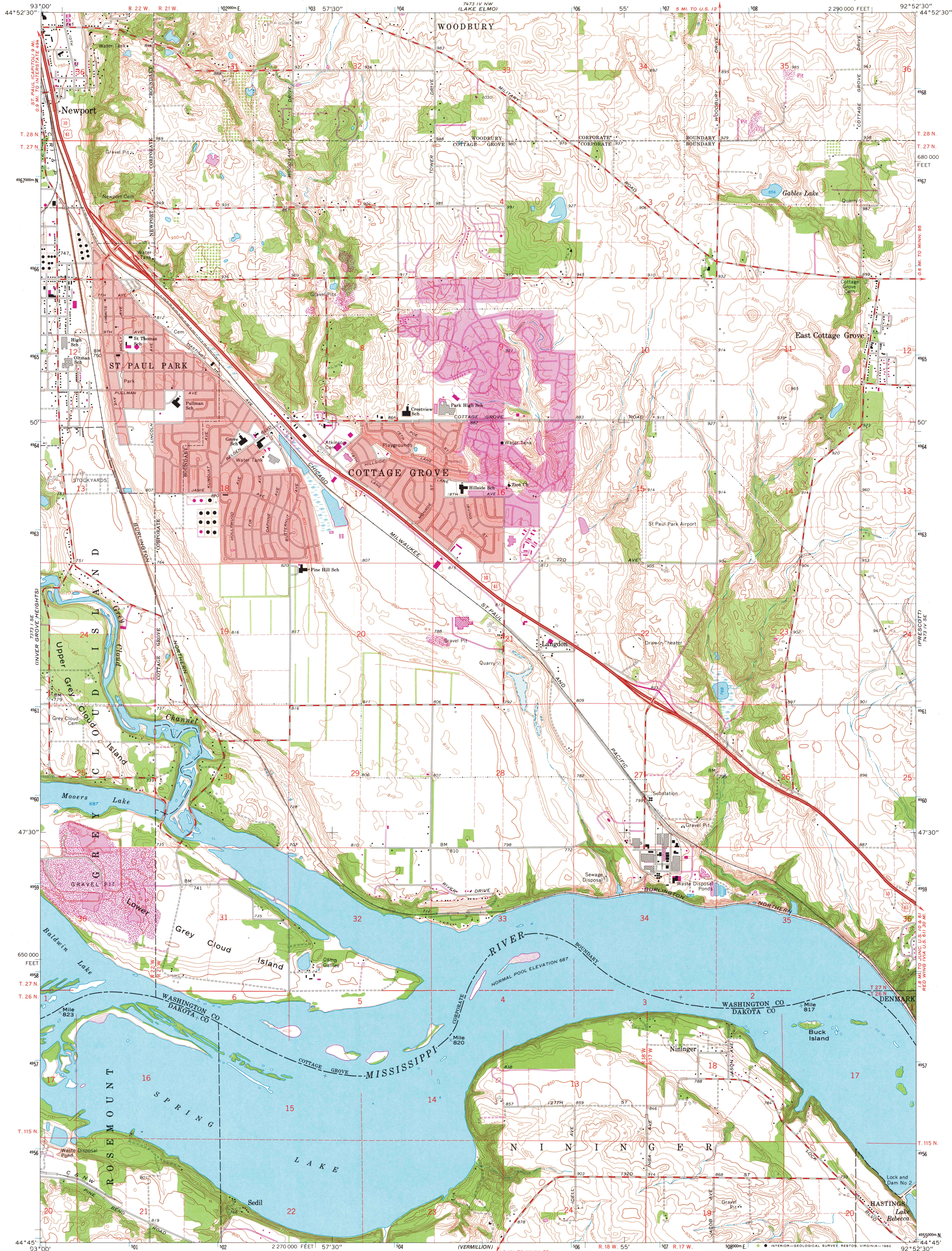

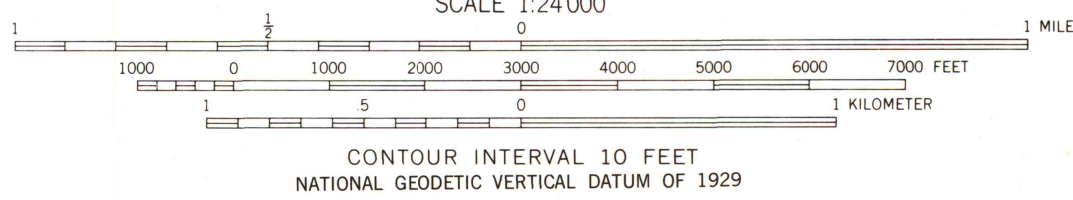

Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 7 meters north and 17 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
