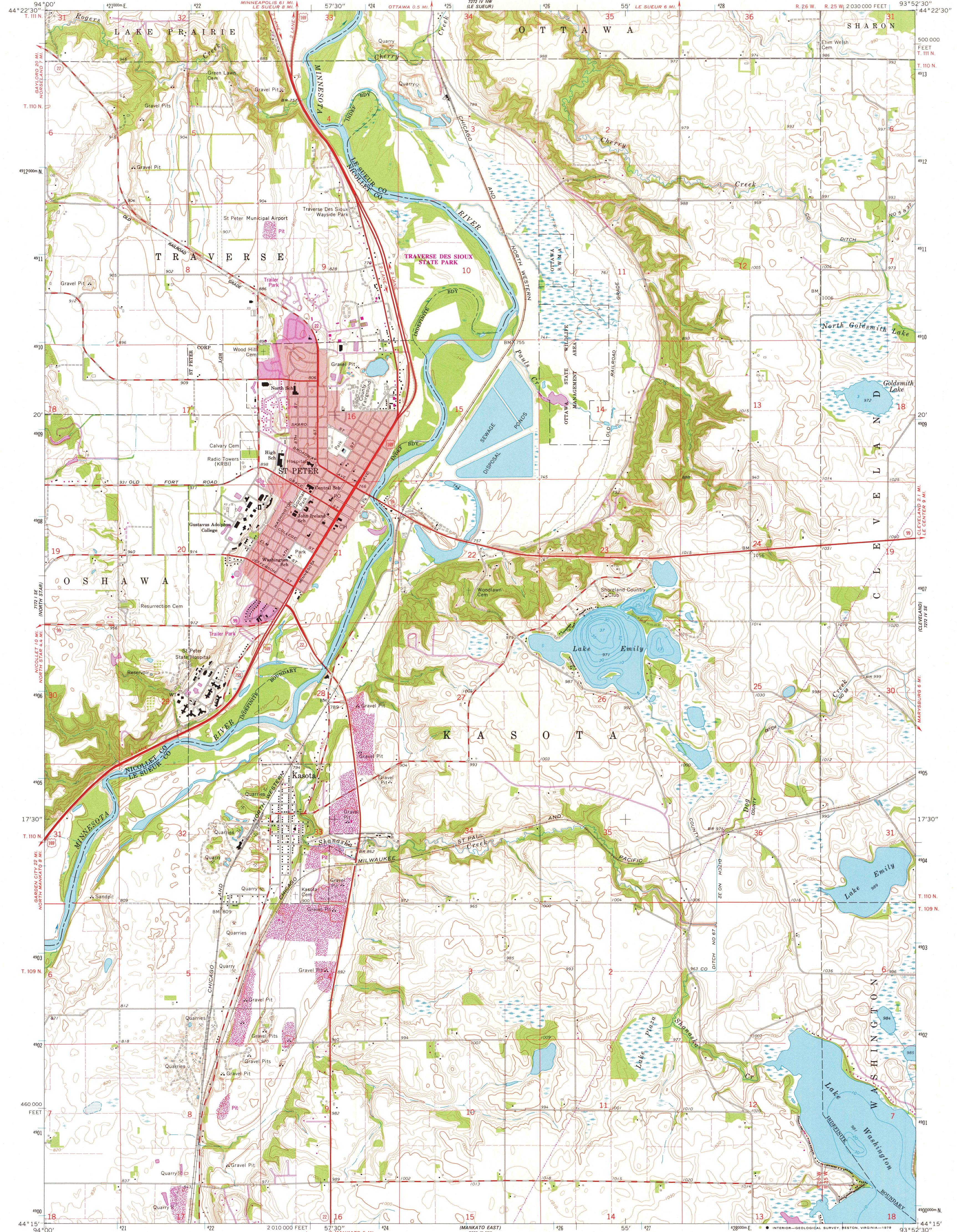
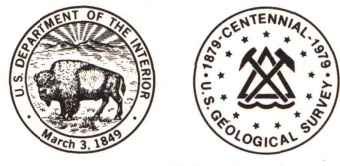

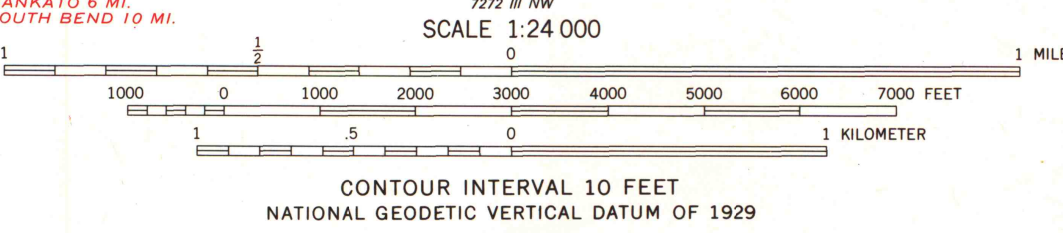
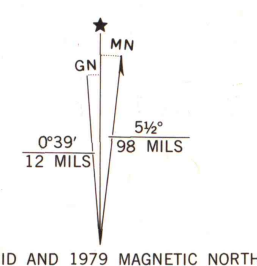
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum

19 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

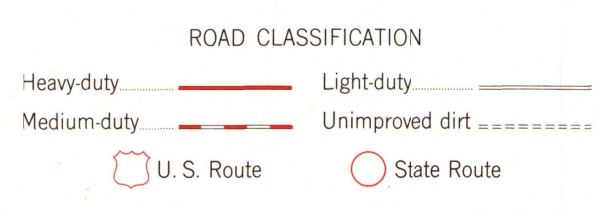
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,
