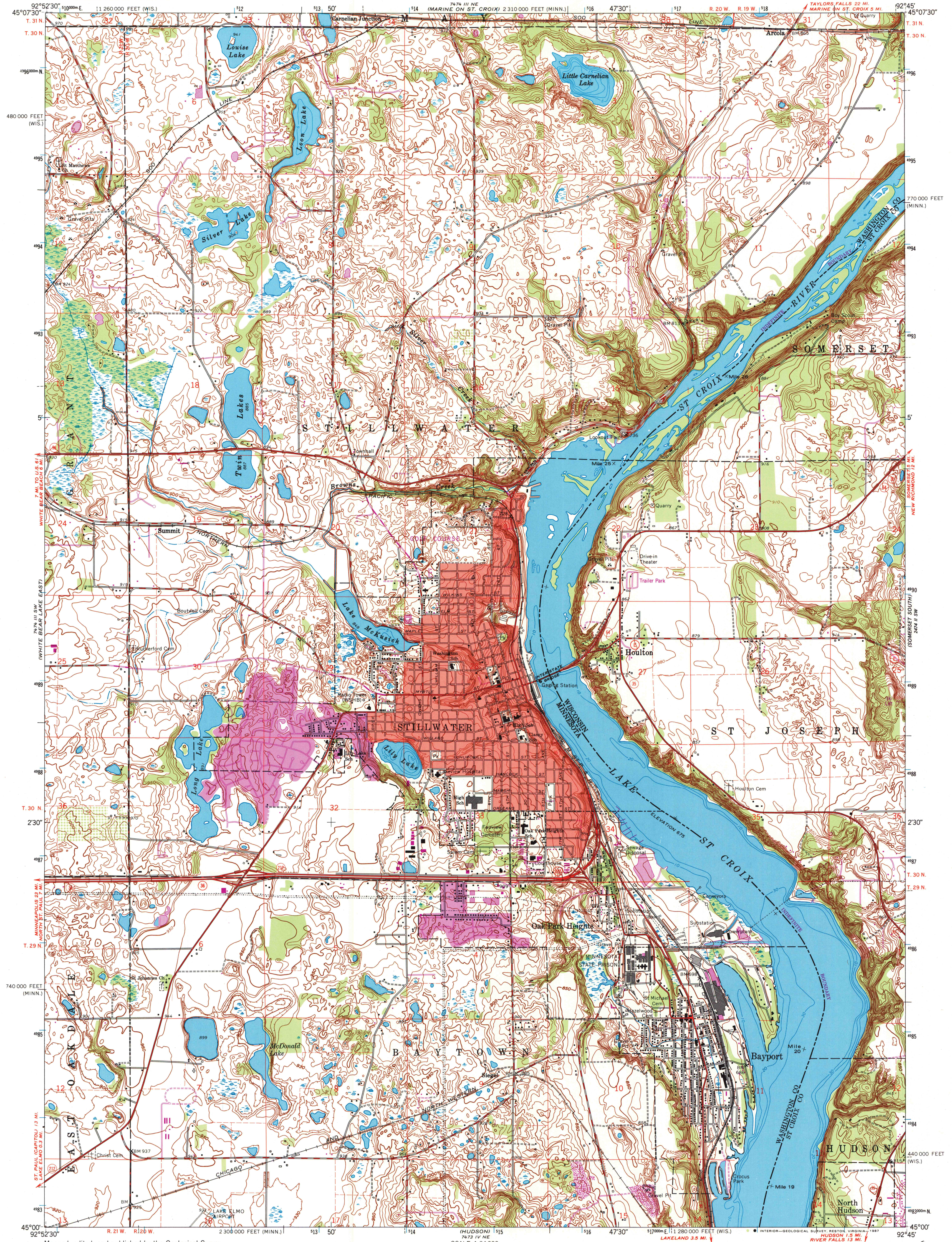

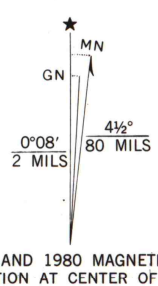

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983
move the projection lines 7 meters north and
16 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
