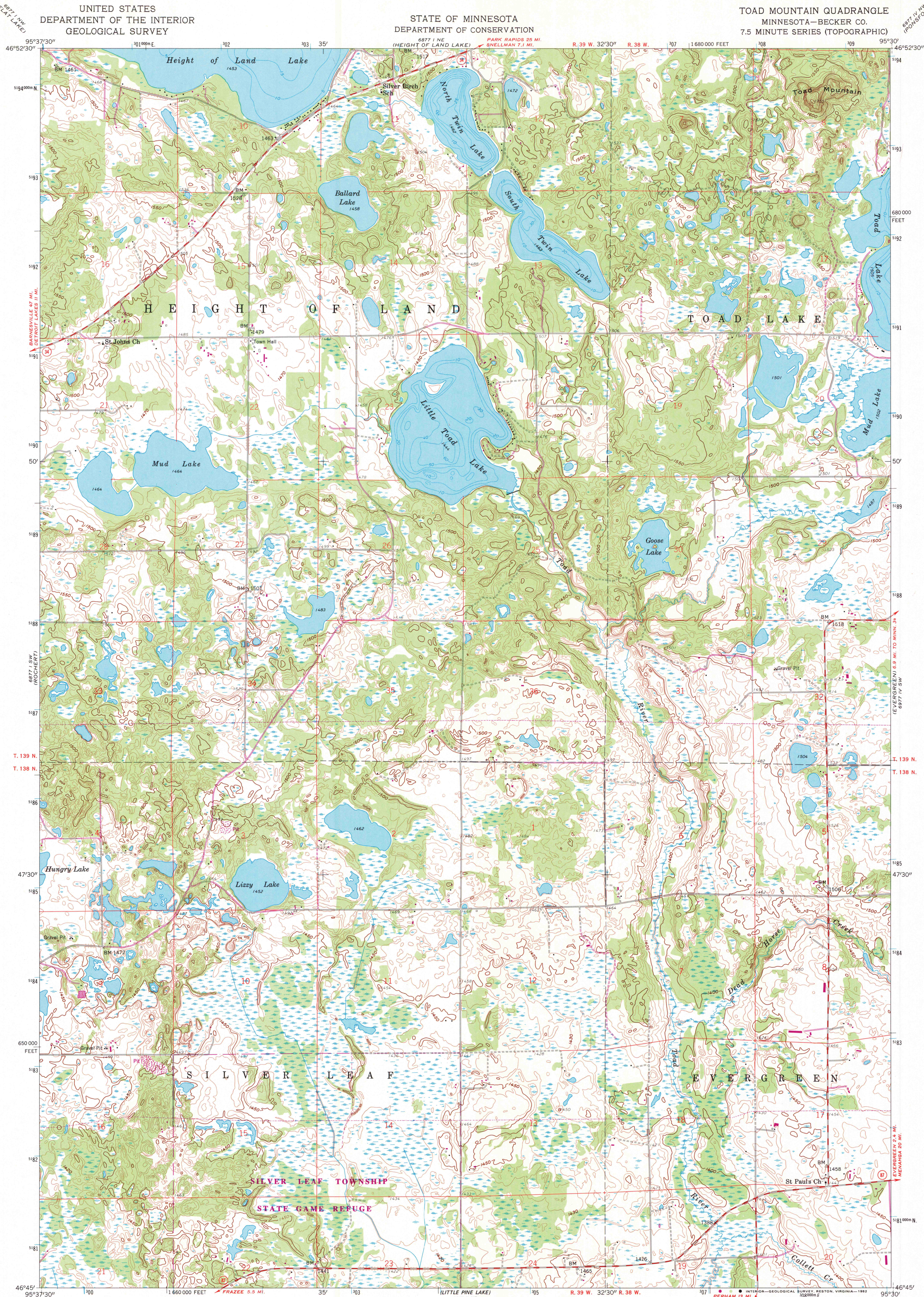

10,000-foot grid based on Minnesota coordinate system, central zone

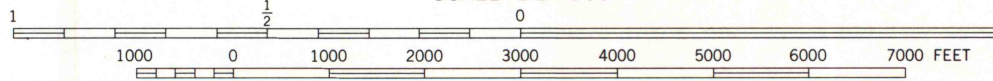
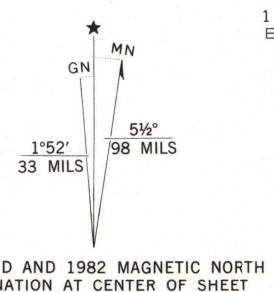
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 15, shown in blue

There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map

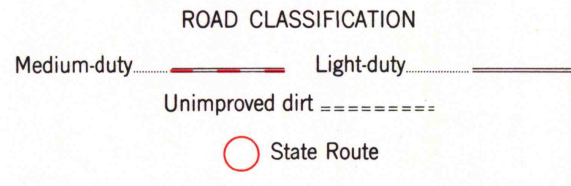


CONTOUR INTERVAL 10 FEET
