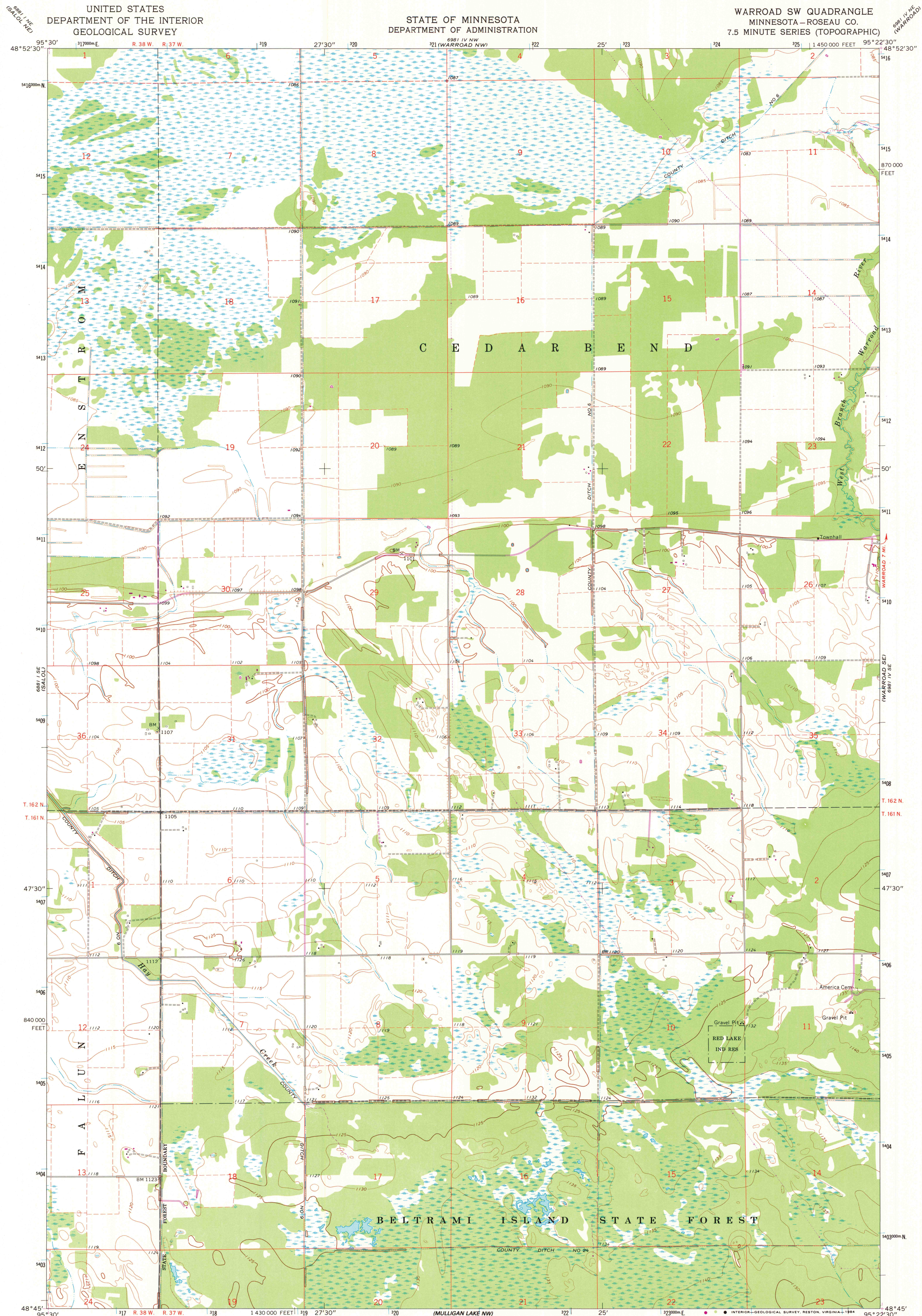

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983, move the projection lines 5 meters north and 19 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations
