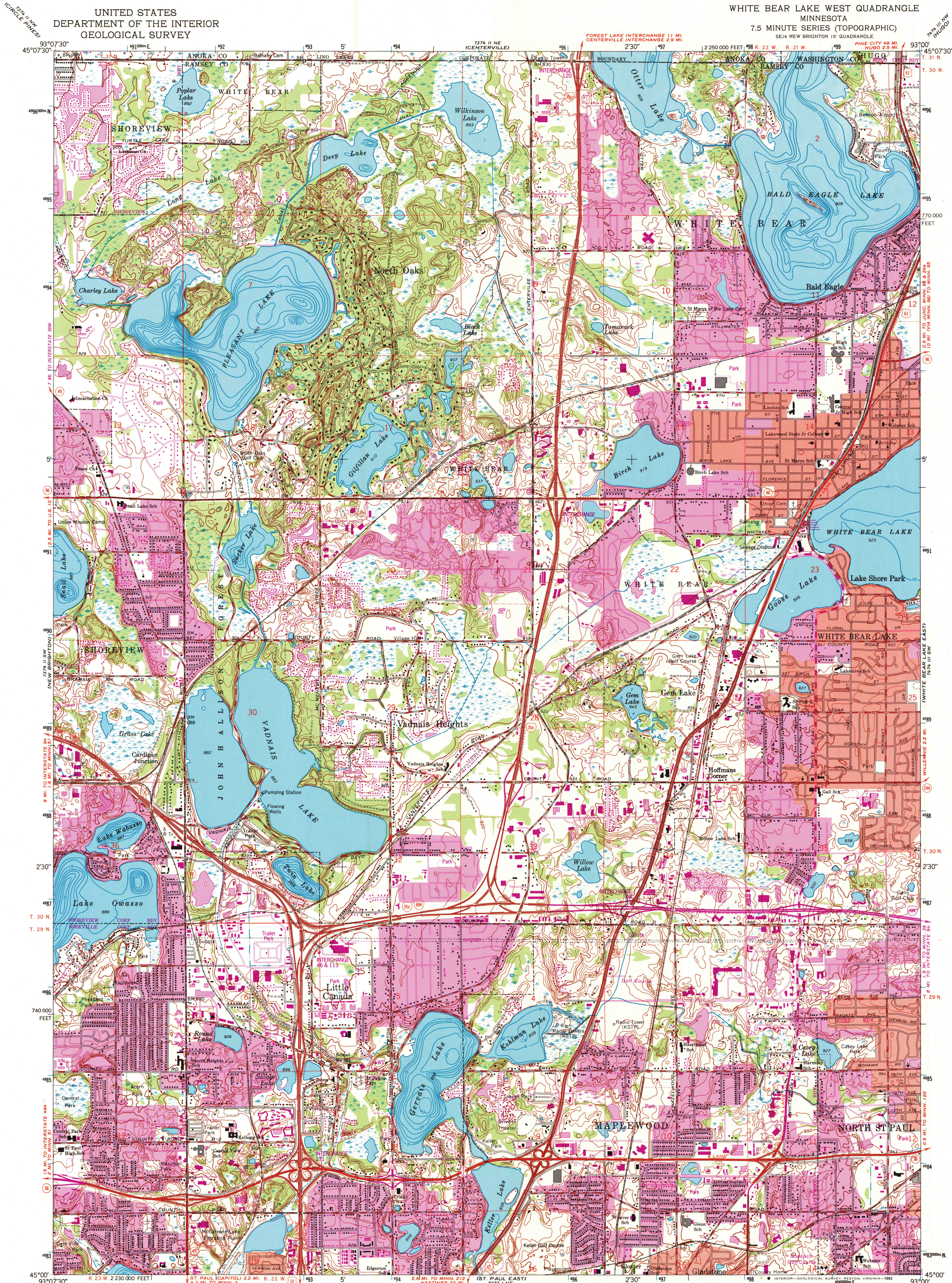

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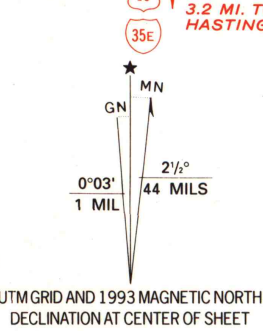

The values of the shift between NAD 27 and NAD 83 for 7.5-minute  
intersections are given in USGS Bulletin 1875.  
Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown.  
Purple tint indicates extension of urban areas.
