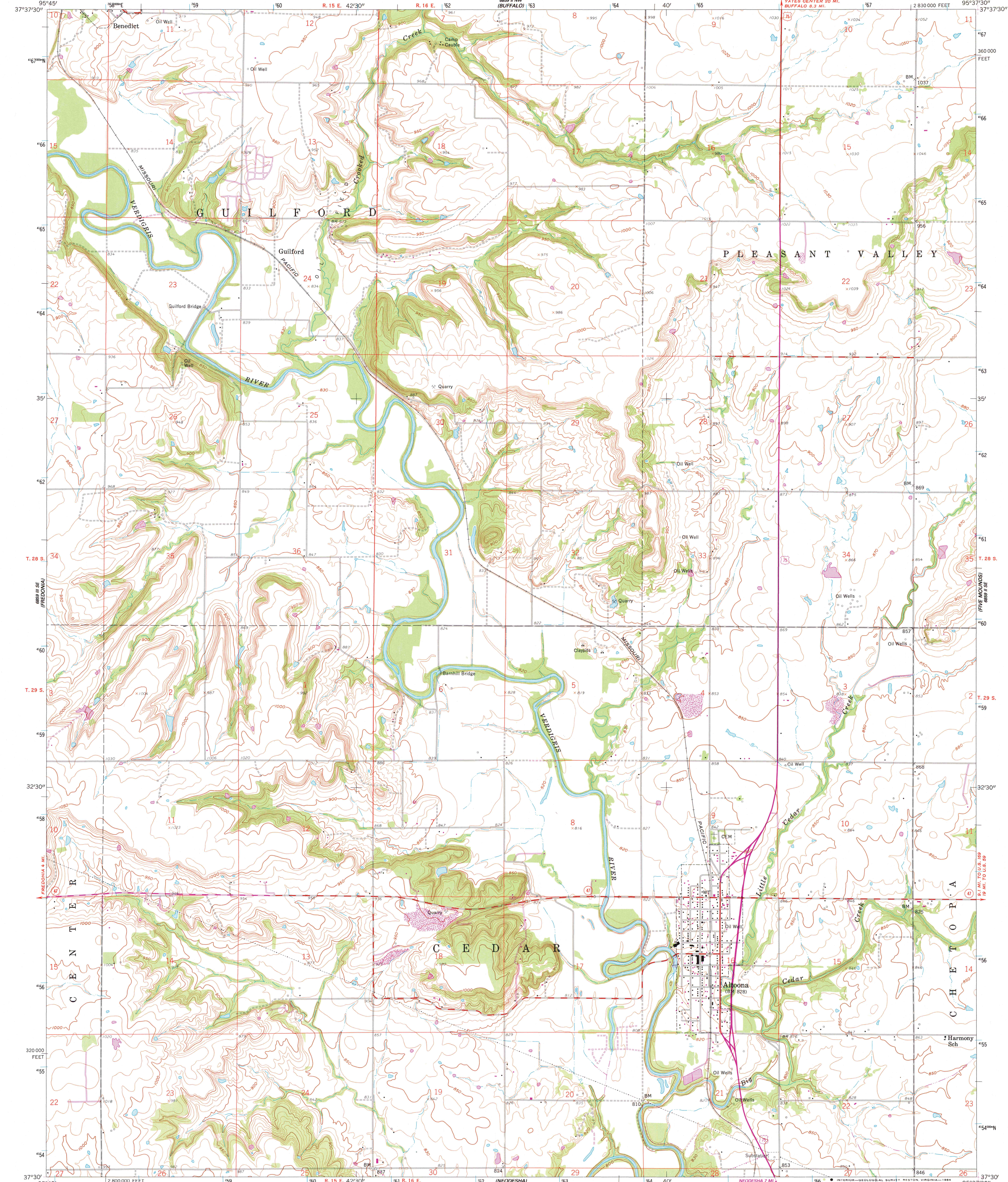

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983, move the projection lines 1 meter south and 23 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
