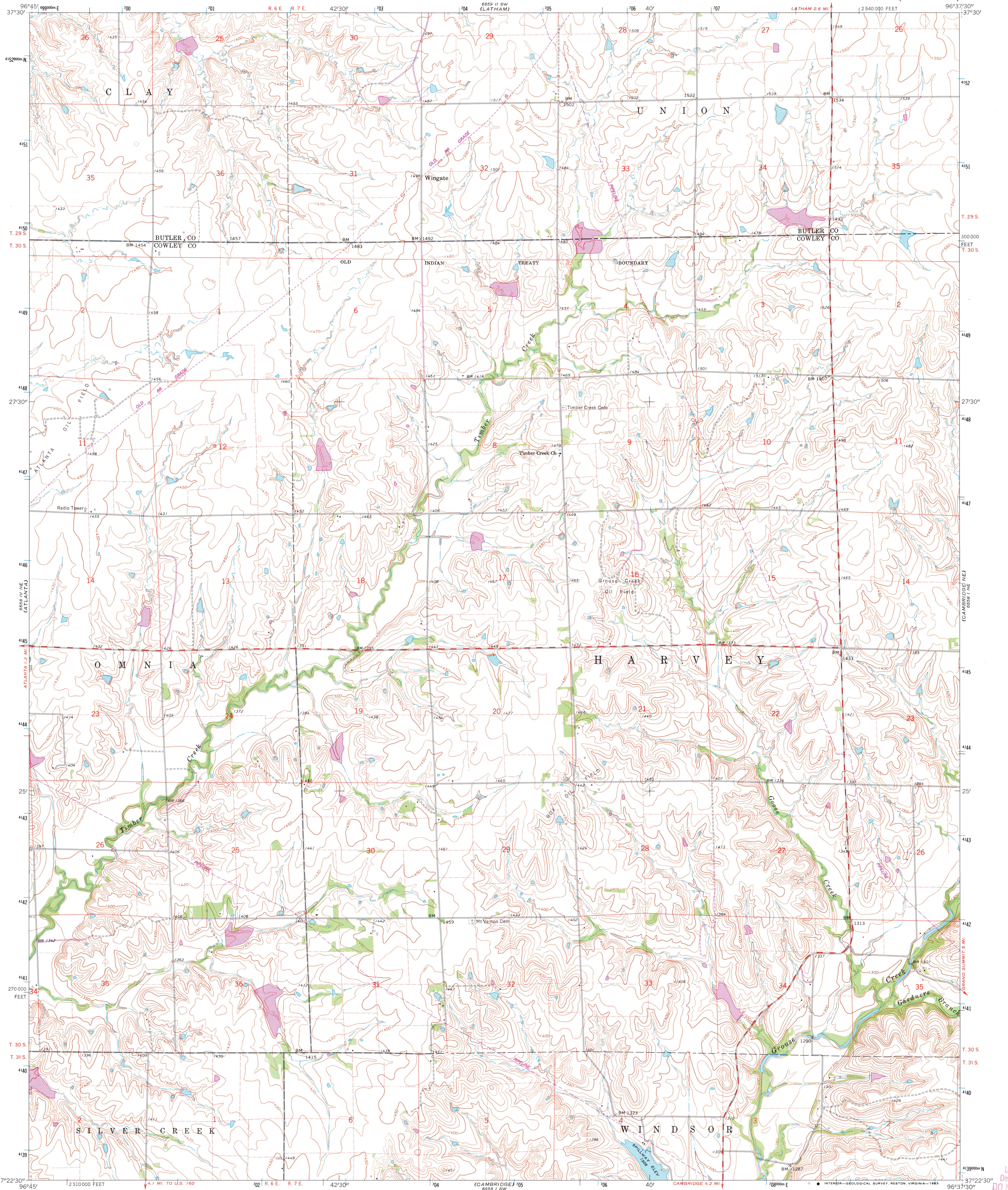

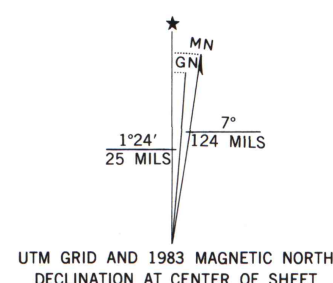

other sources. This information not field checked. Map edited 1983



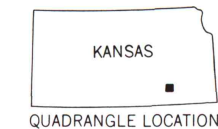
UTM GRID AND 1983 MAGNETIC NORTH
