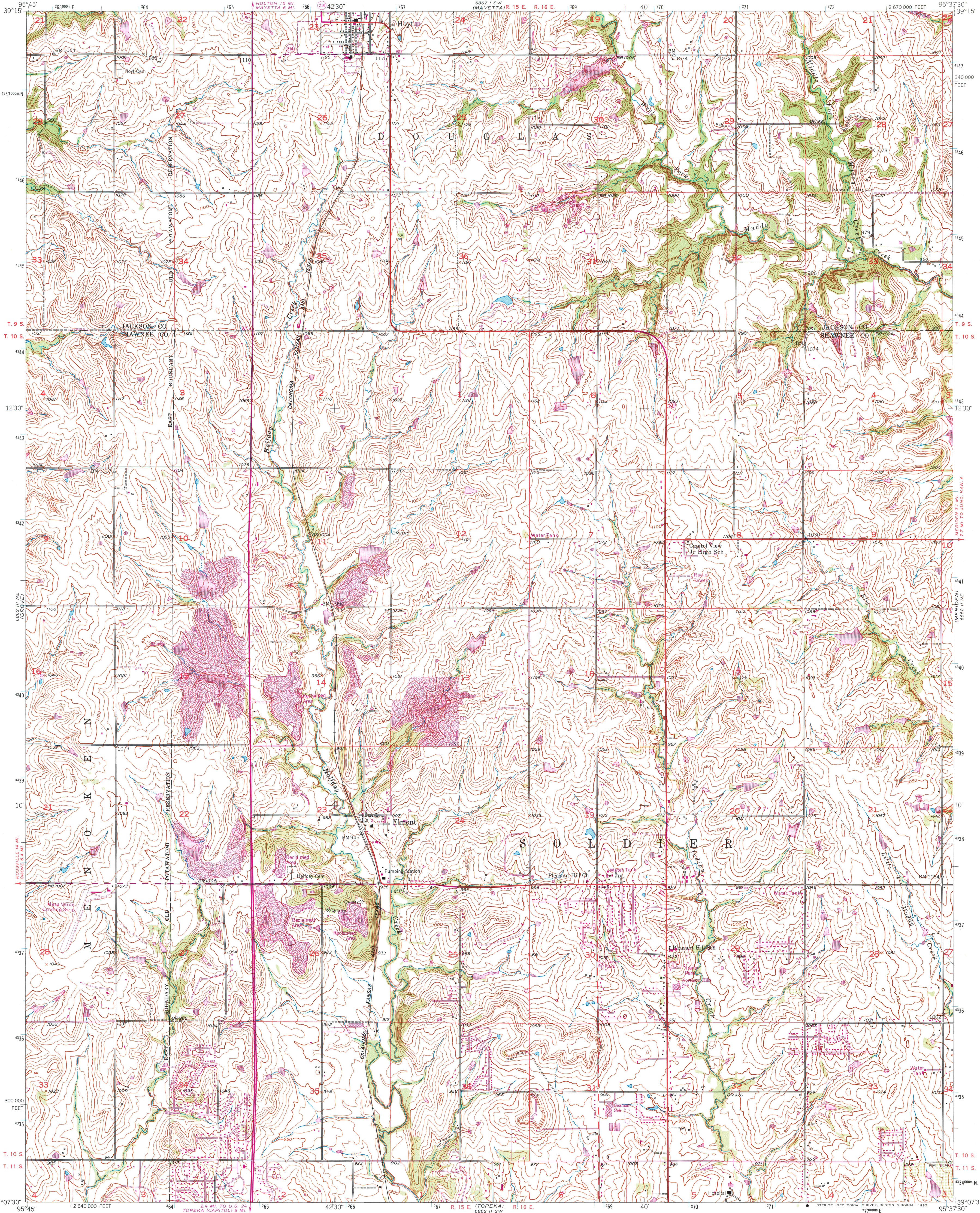

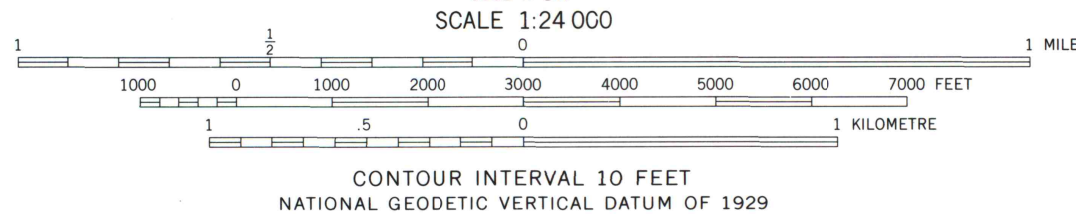
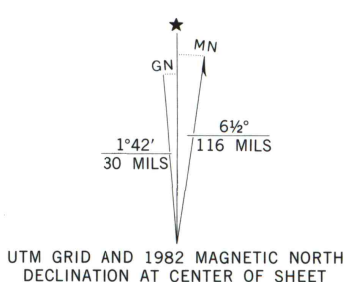
Topography from aerial photographs by Kelsh plotter

zone 15, shown in blue

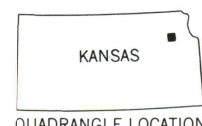
Dotted land lines by Bureau of Indian Affairs
