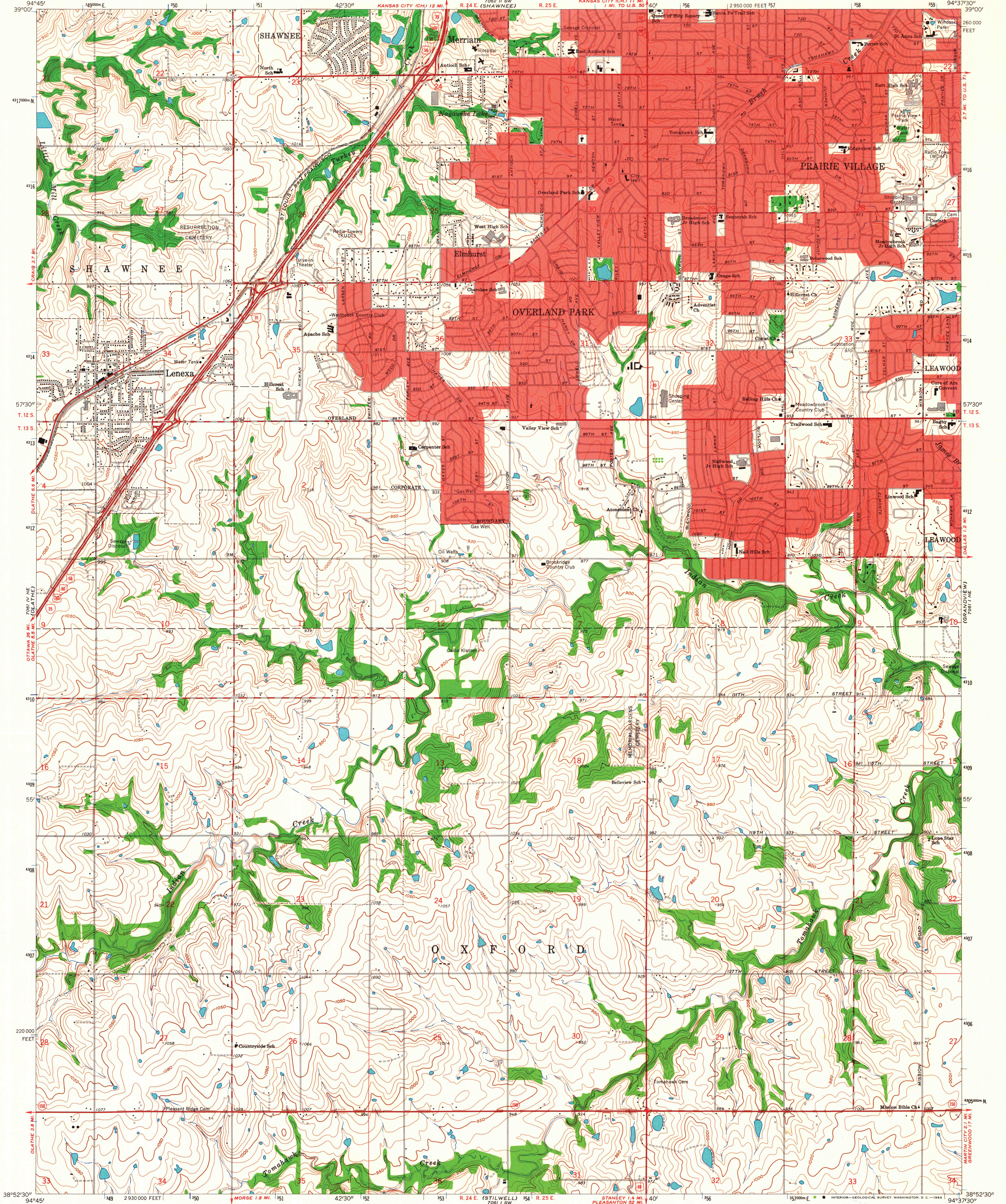




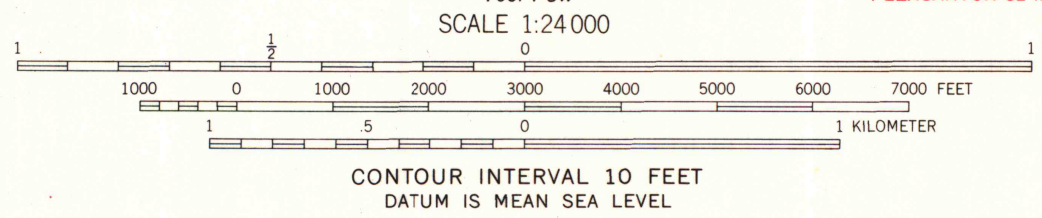
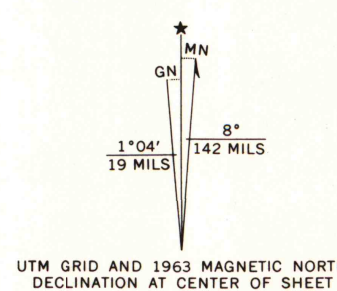

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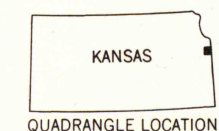
Planimetry by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1955. Topography by planetable surveys 1935. Revised 1963
