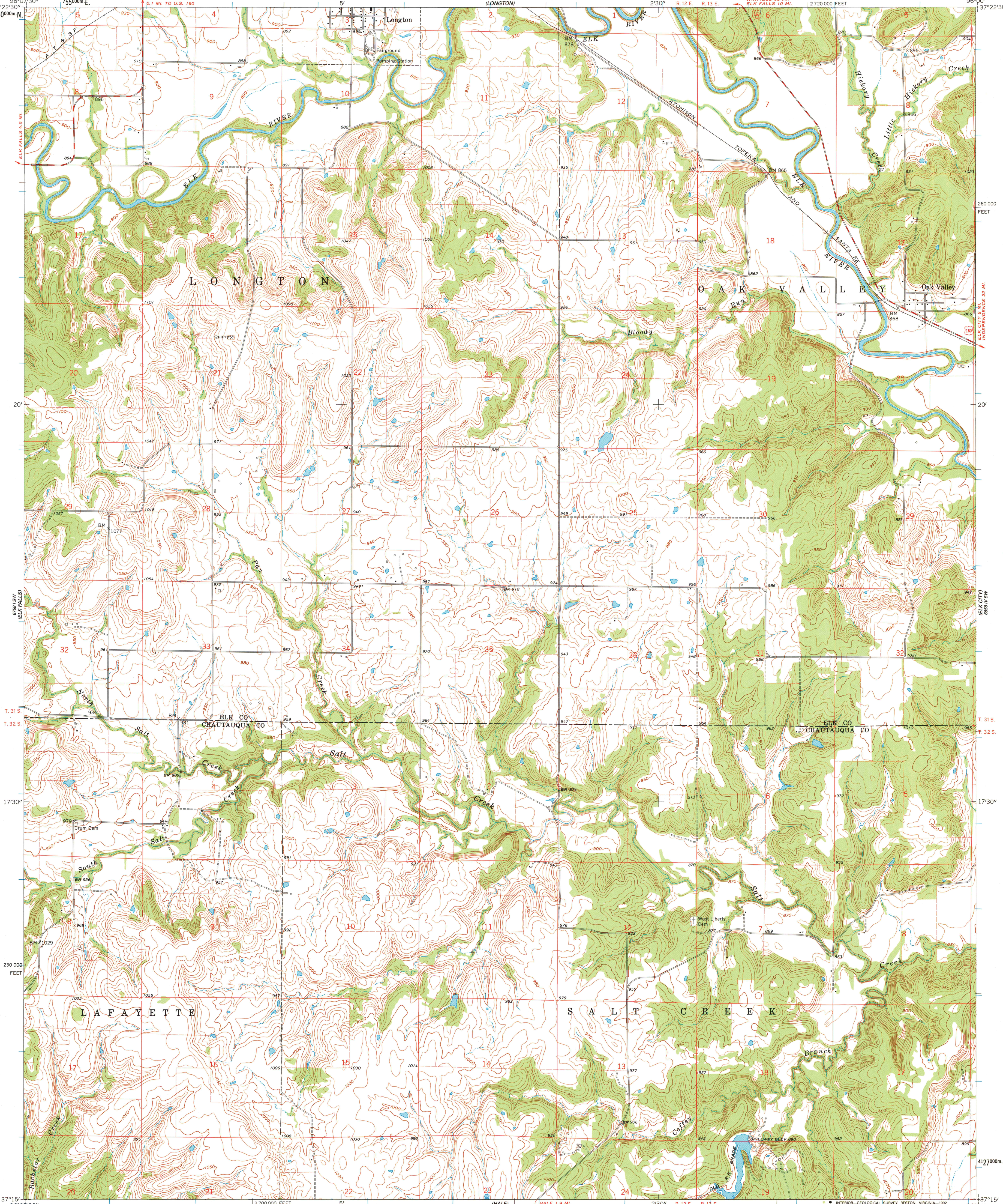




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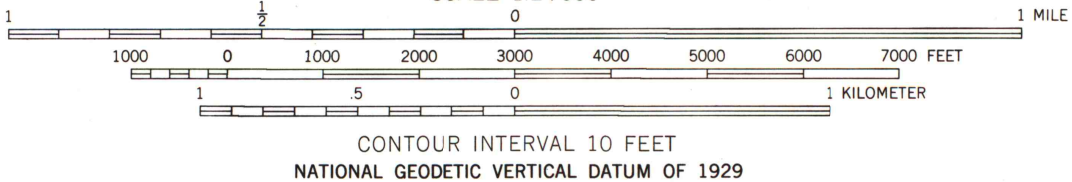
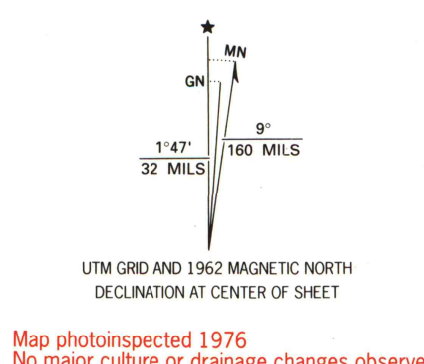
Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1960. Field checked 1962

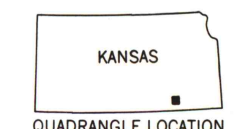
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked
