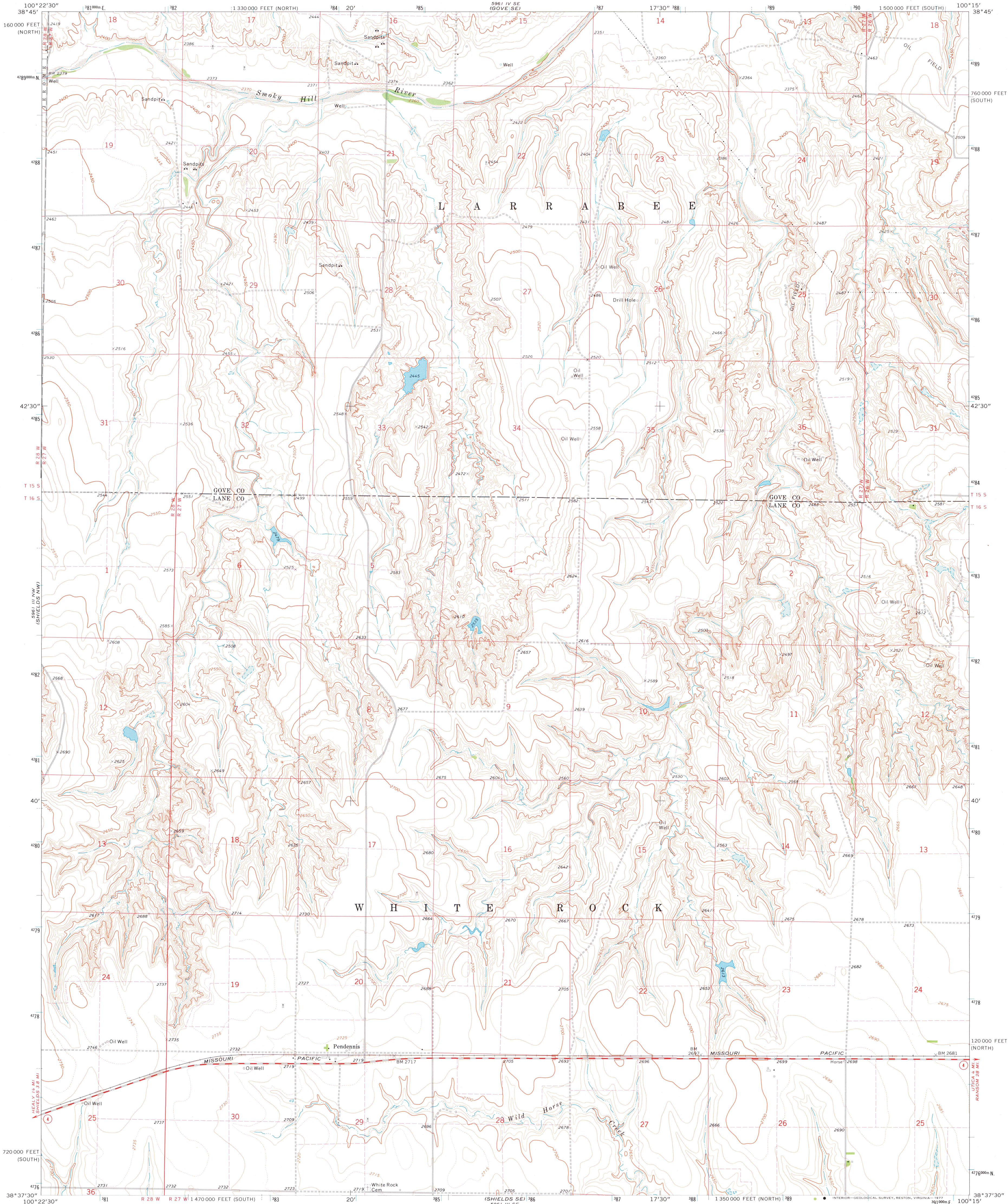

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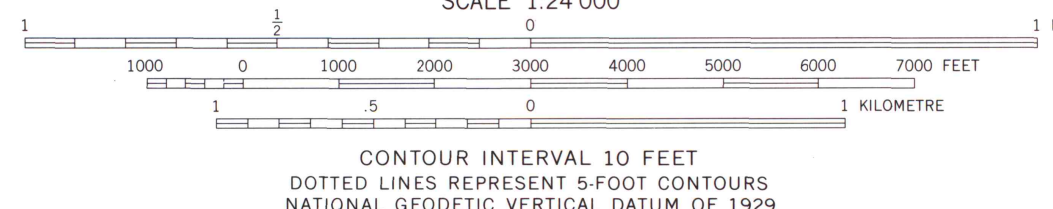
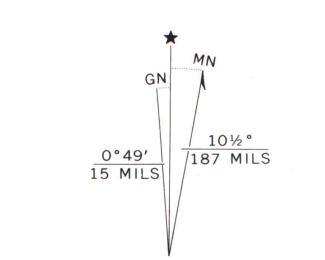

(Lambert conformal conic)

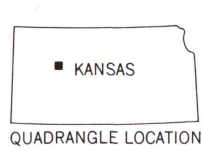
10,000-foot grid ticks based on Kansas coordinate
