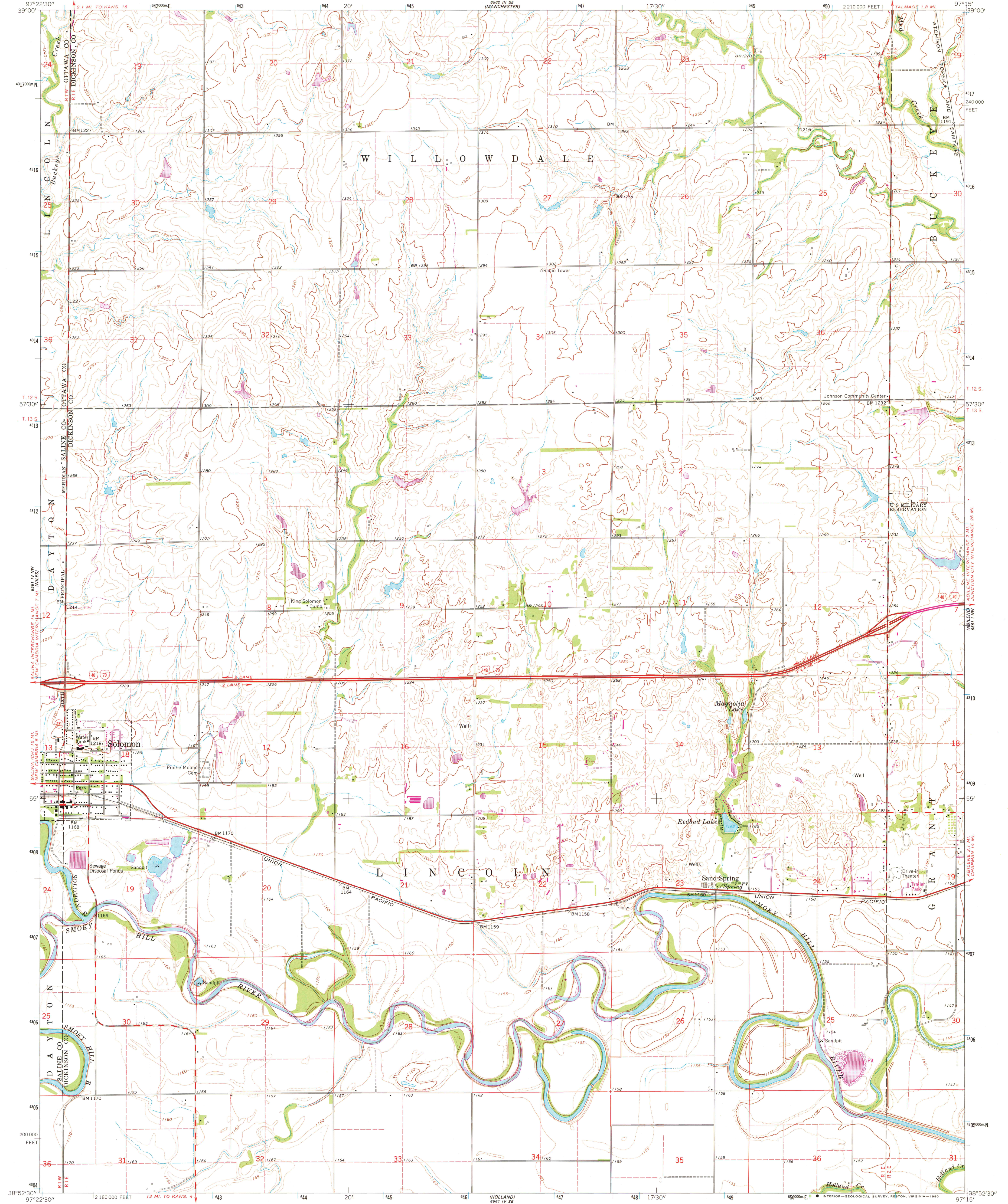

move the projection lines 2 meters north and

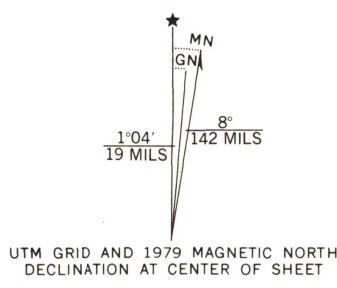
27 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
