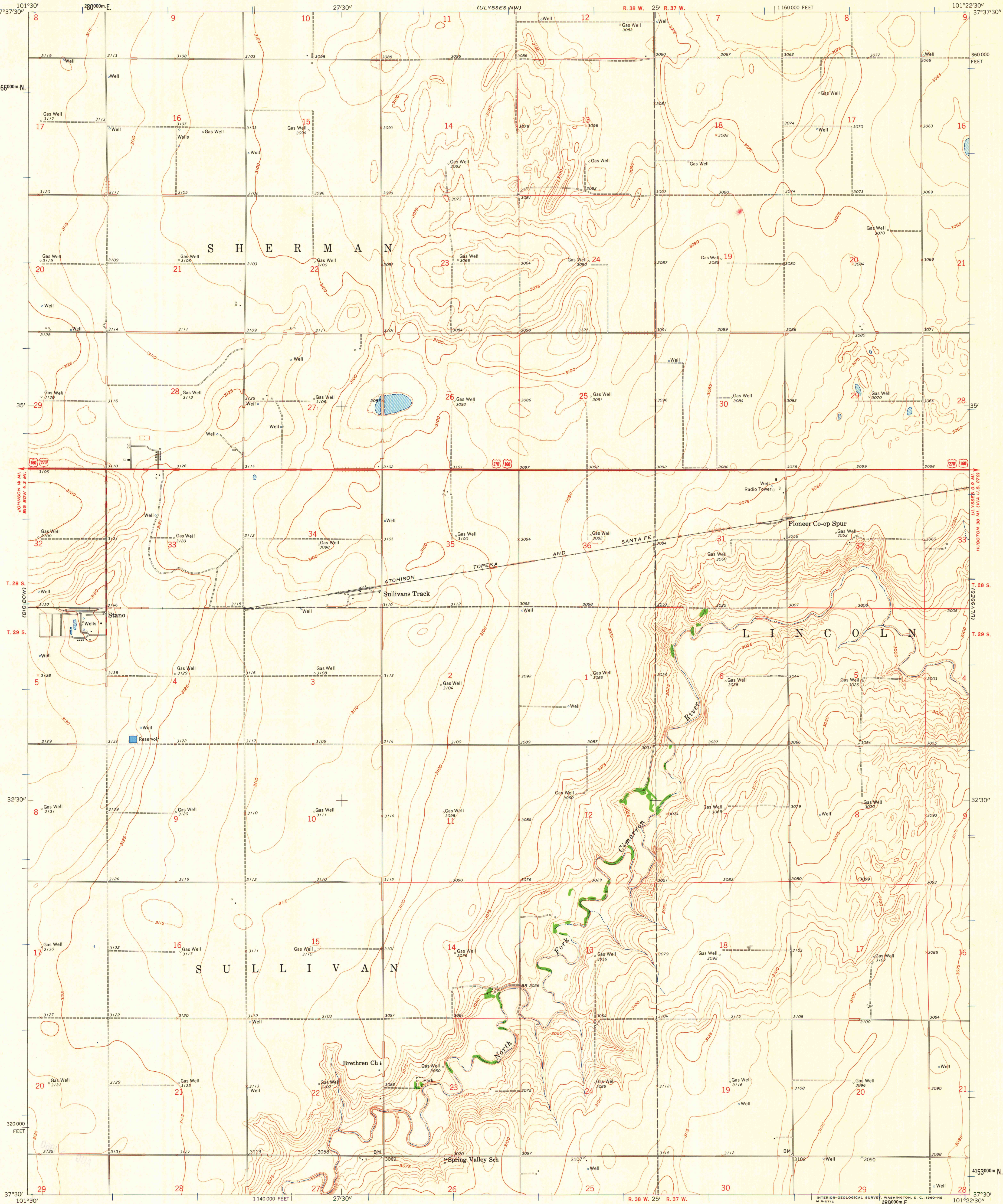


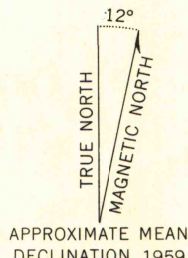


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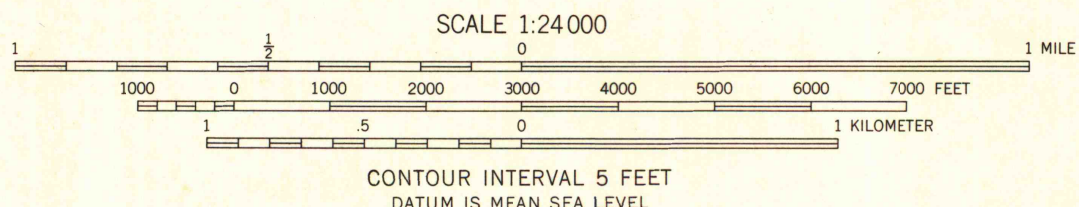

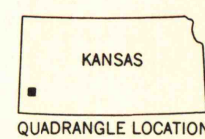
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum

zone 14, shown in blue



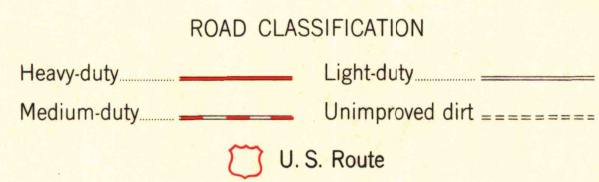
APPROXIMATE MEAN
