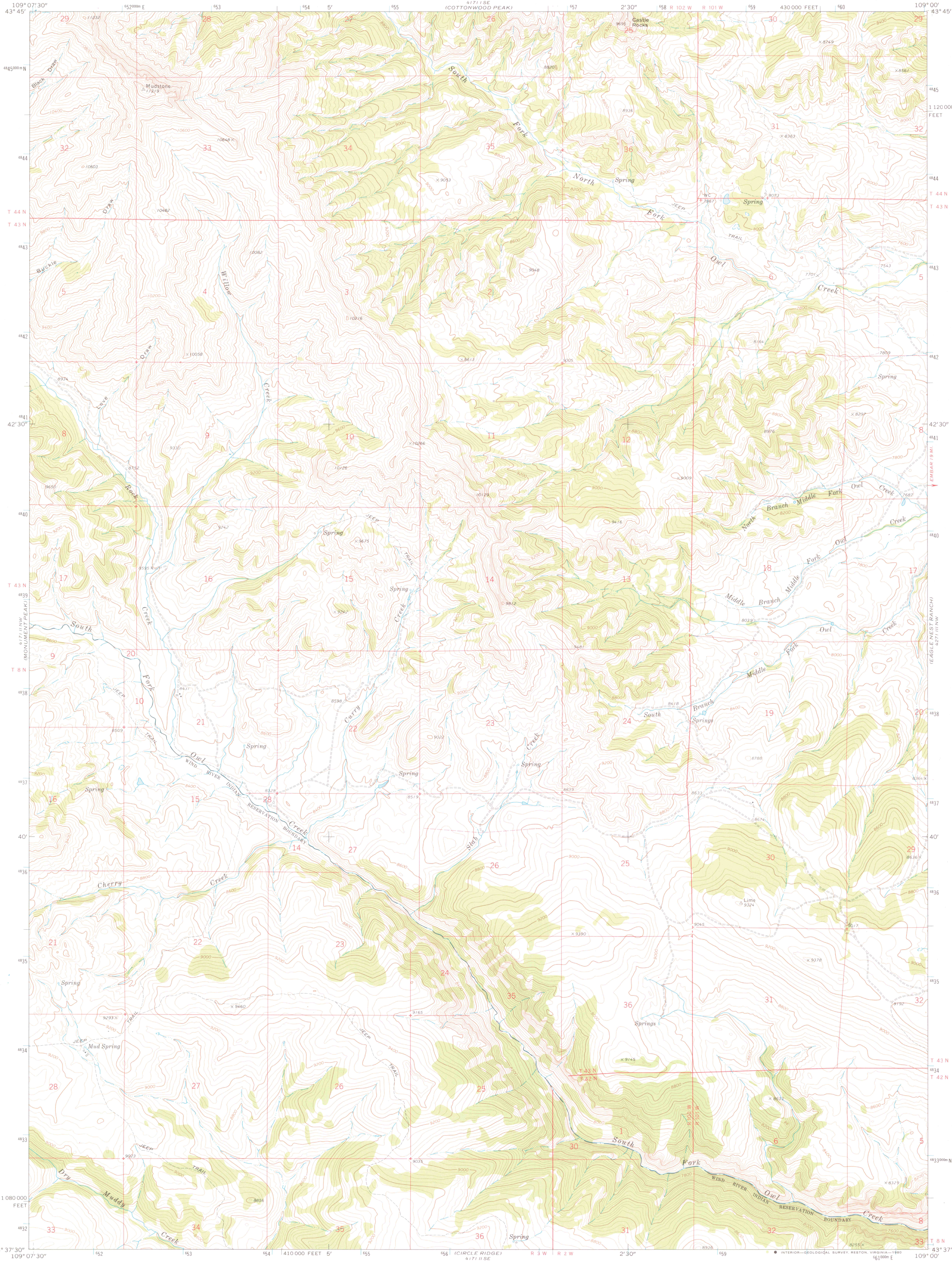

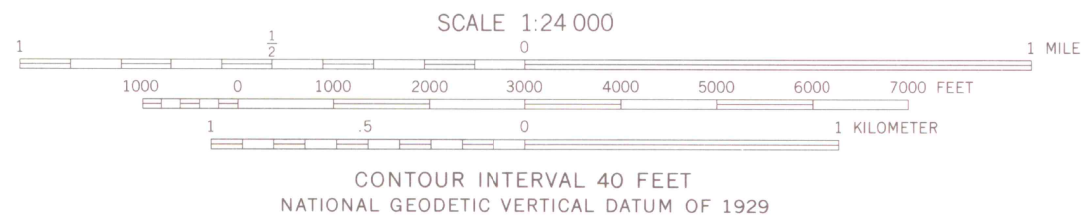
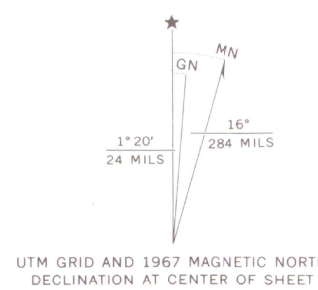

zone 12, shown in blue

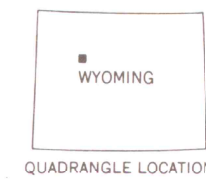
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move
