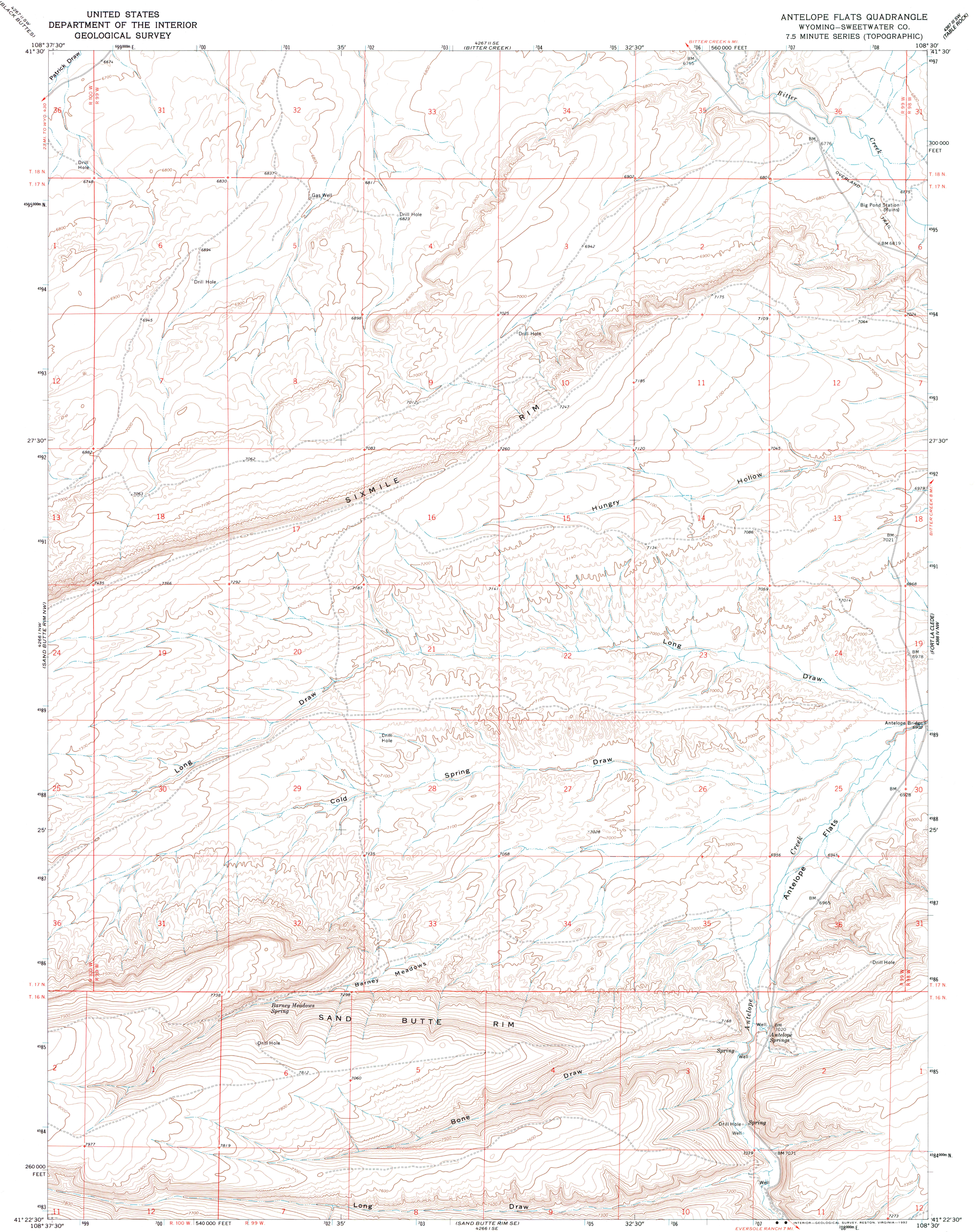

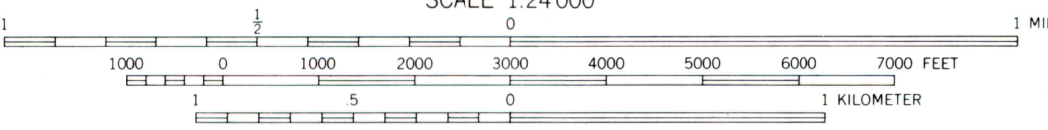
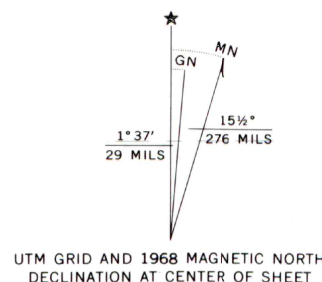

zone 12, shown in blue

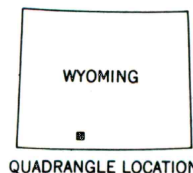
The difference between 1927 North American Datum and North
