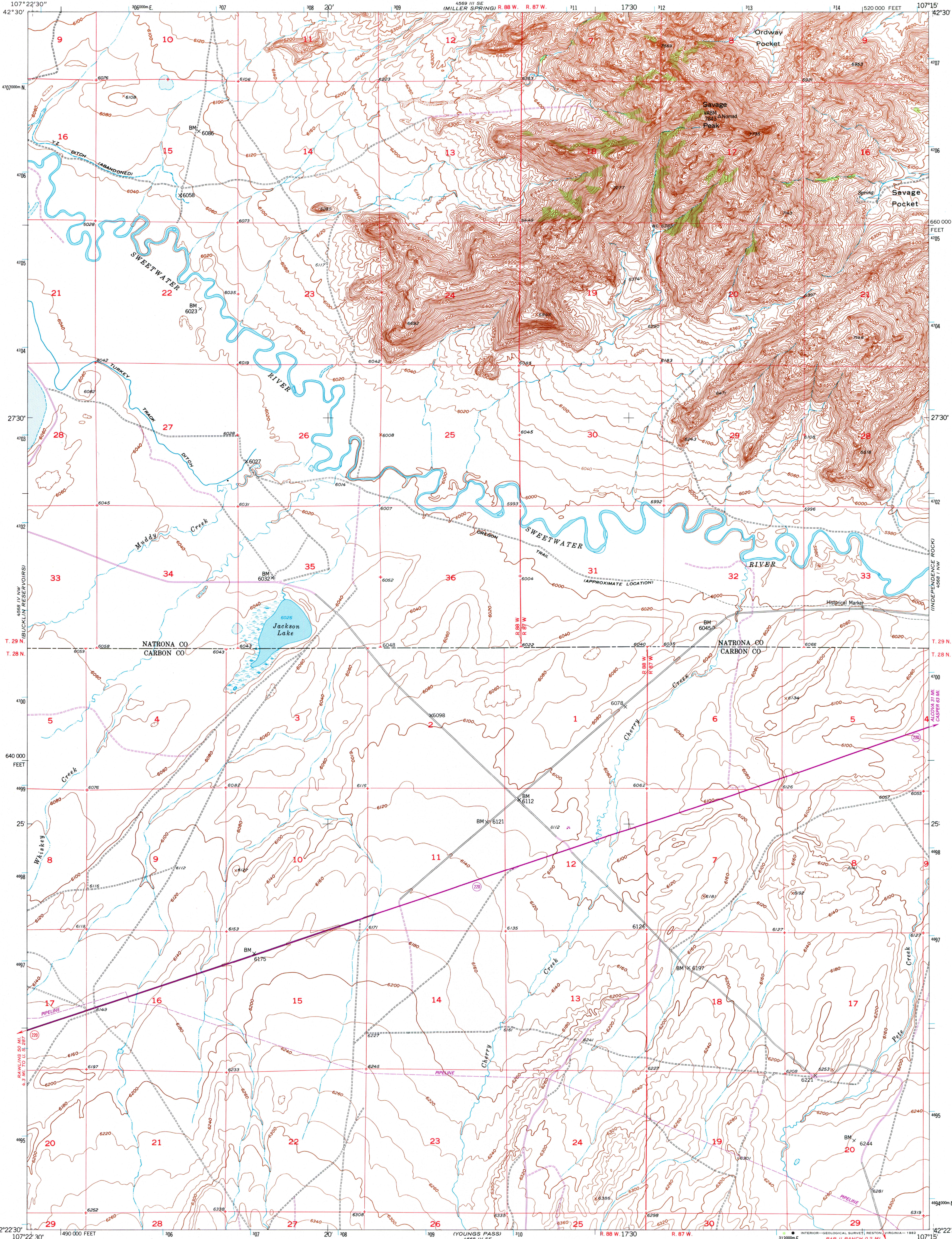

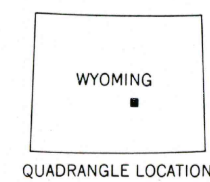
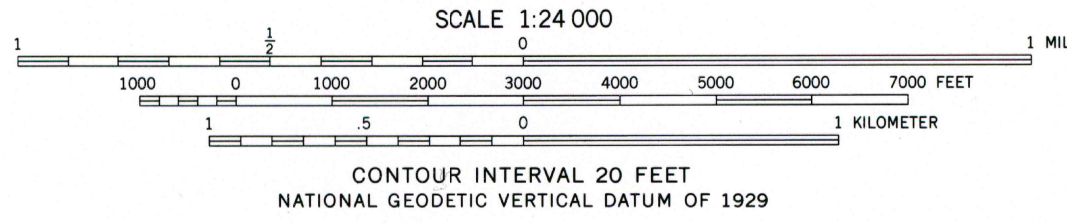
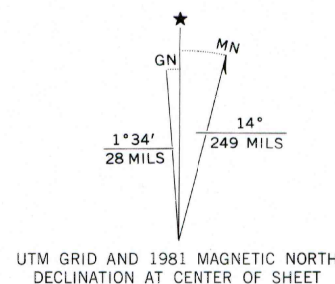
Topography from aerial photographs by multiplex methods 1950 and plane-table surveys 1951. Aerial photographs taken 1947

10,000-foot grid based on Wyoming coordinate system, east central zone

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 13, shown in blue

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 8 meters north and 51 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
