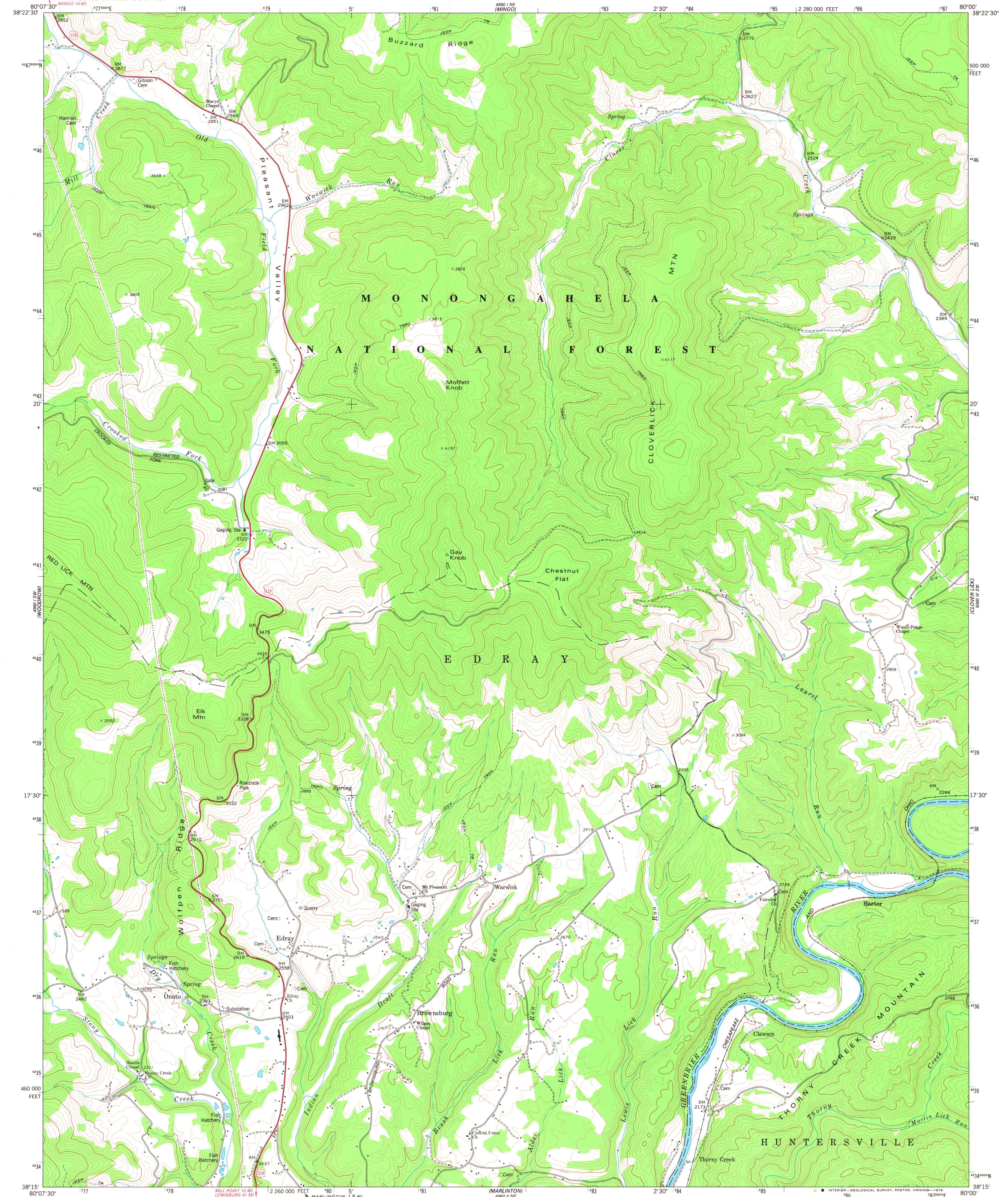

Projection and 10,000-foot grid ticks: West Virginia coordinate

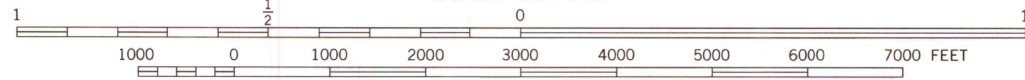
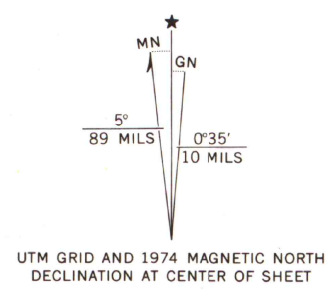
