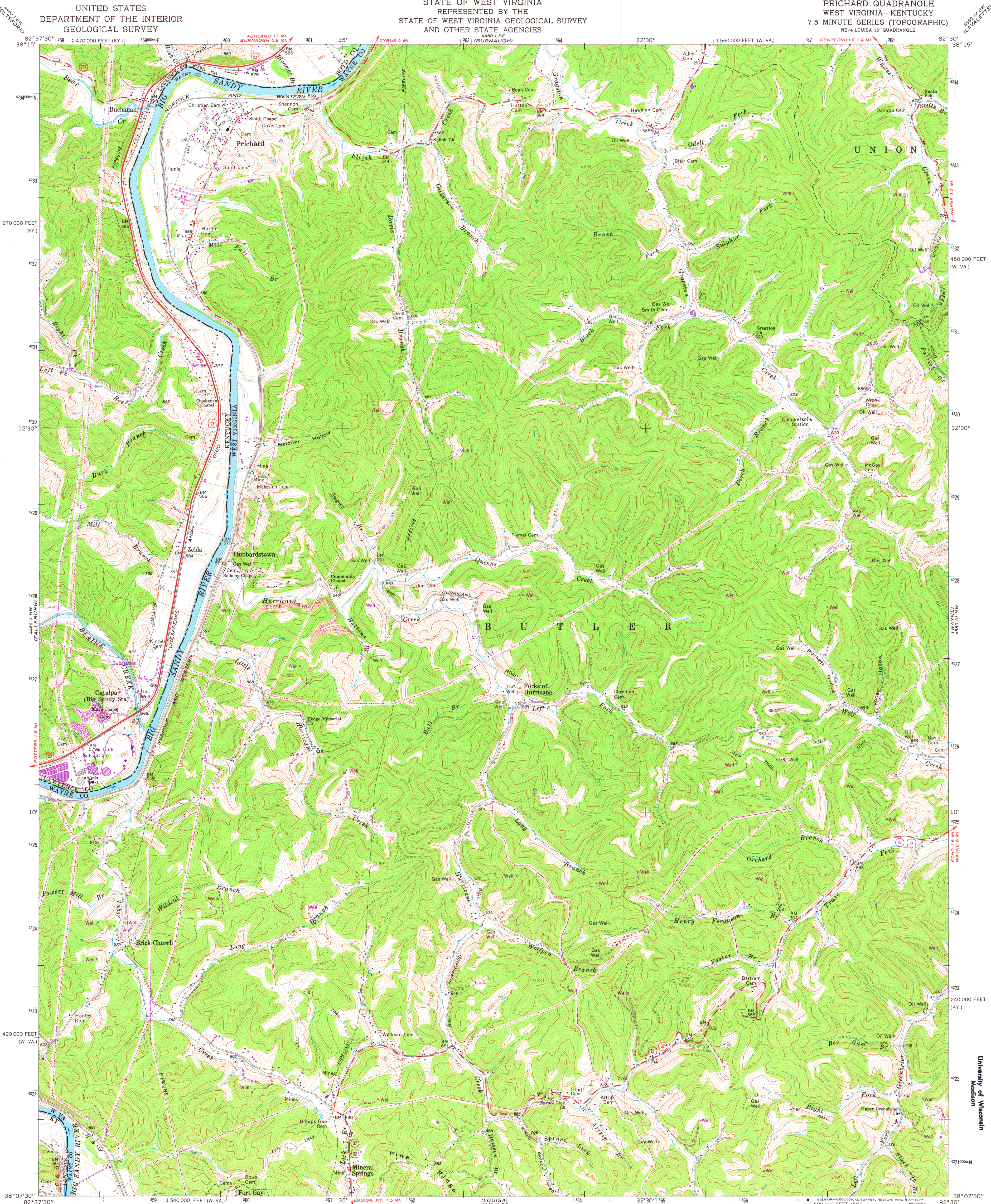

Topography in Kentucky by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1952. Field checked 1953

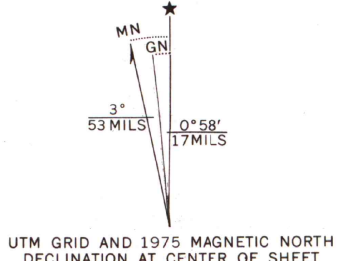
