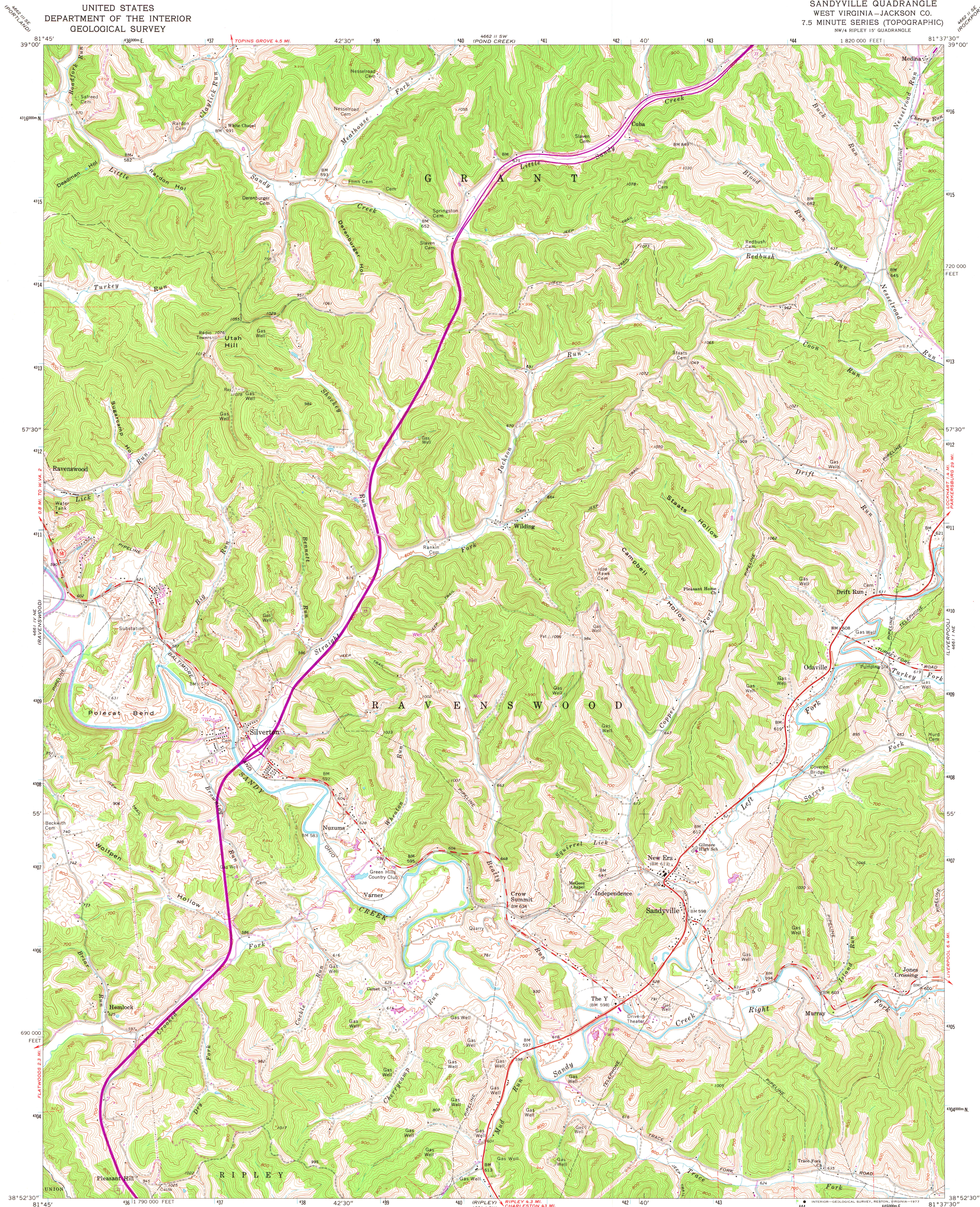

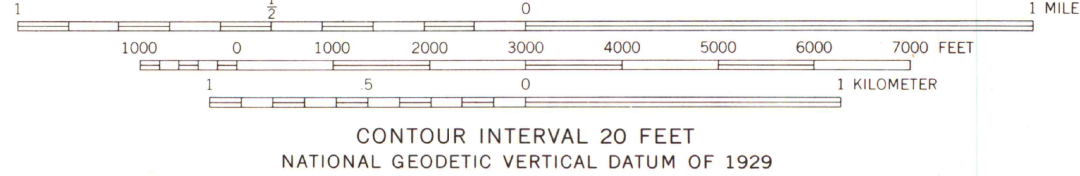
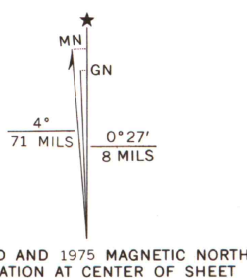
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum

zone 17, shown in blue

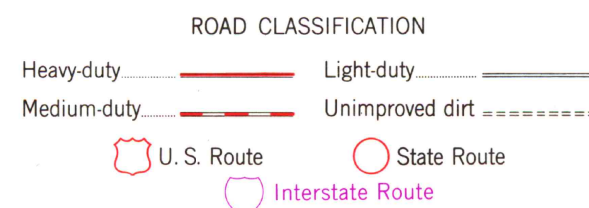
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where
