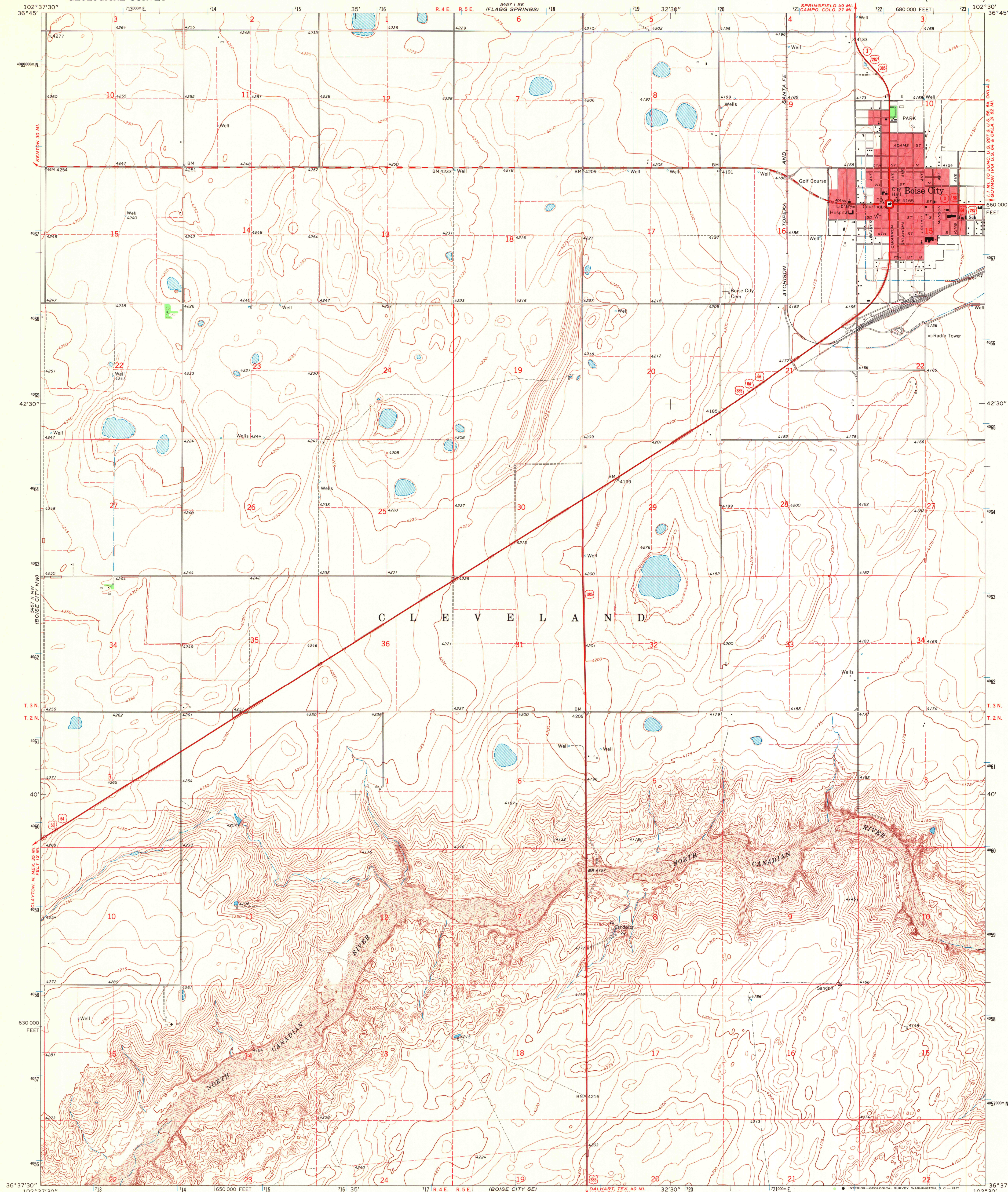

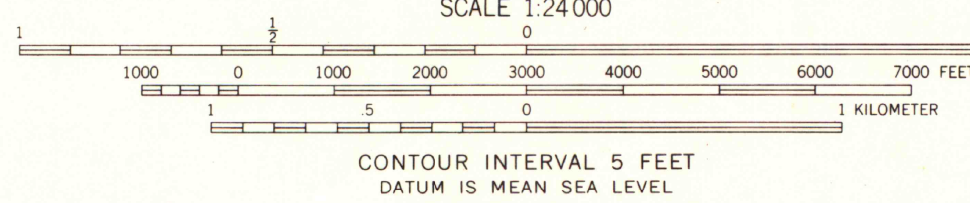

zone 13, shown in blue

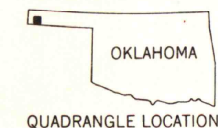
Red tint indicates area in which only landmark buildings are shown
