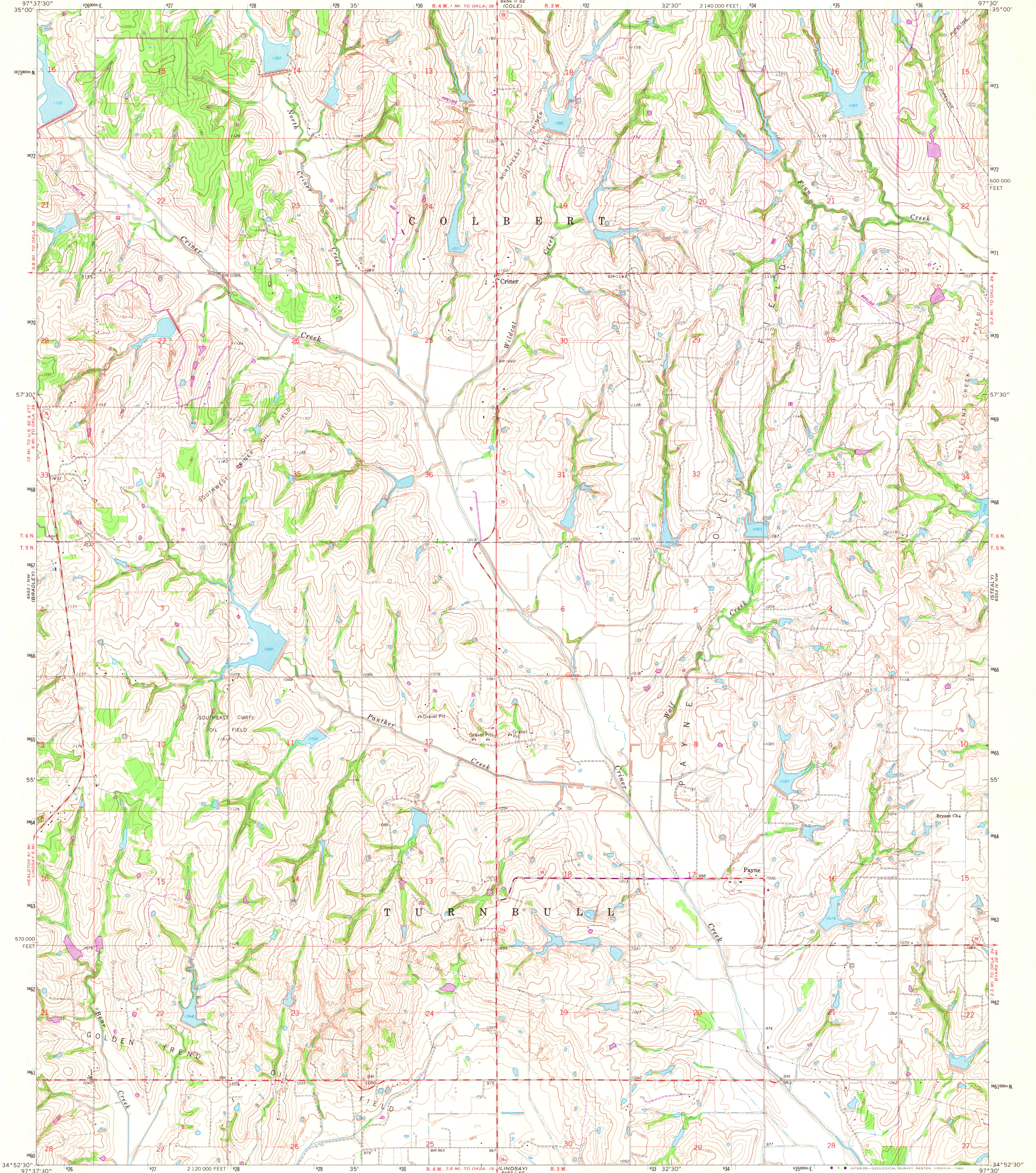

generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked

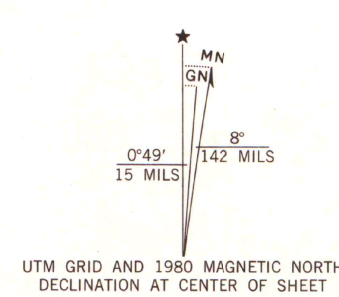
