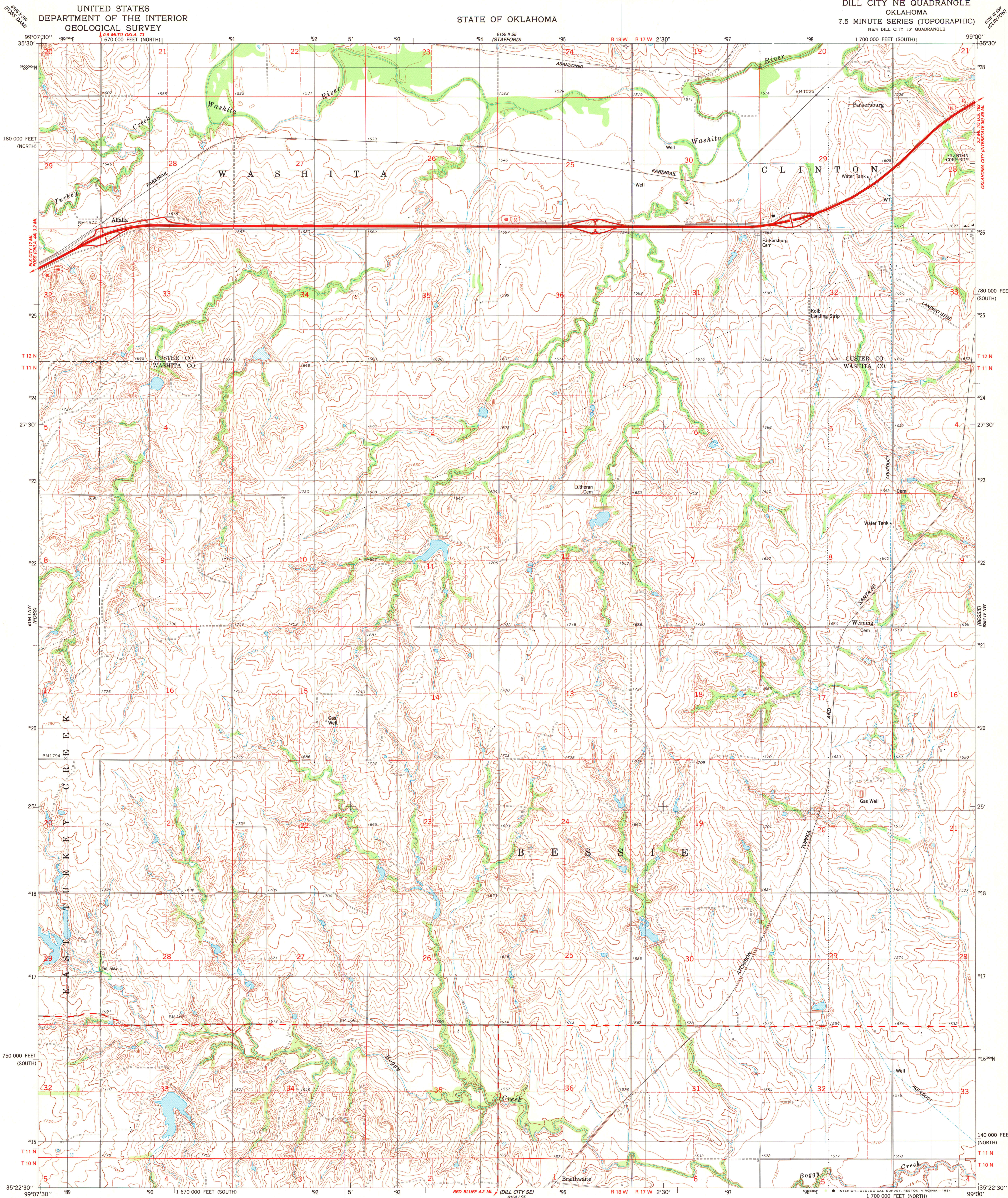

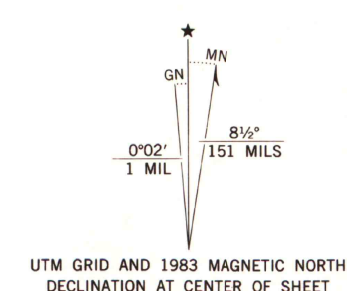
10,000-foot grid ticks based on Oklahoma coordinate system, south and north zones
