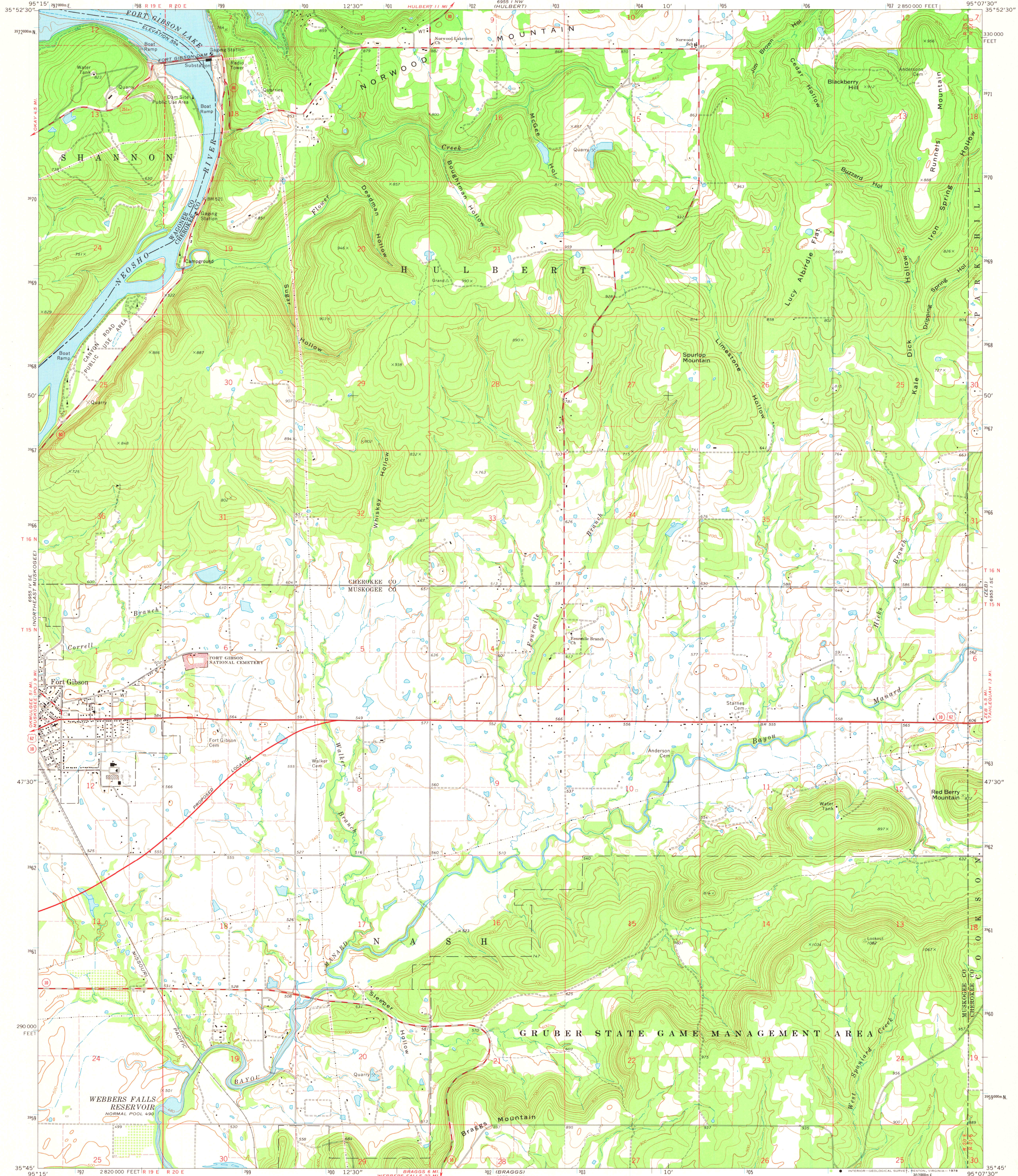

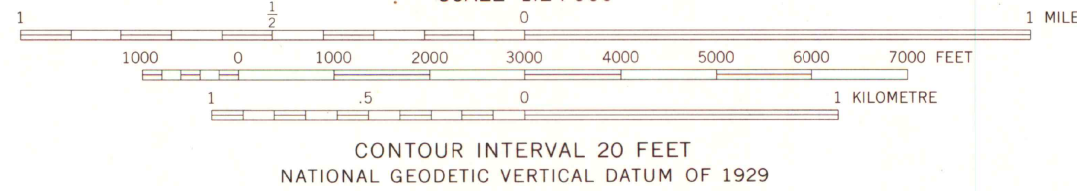
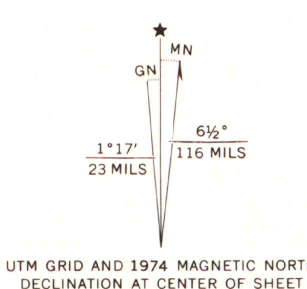

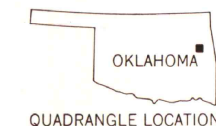
Projection and 10,000-foot grid ticks: Oklahoma coordinate system, north zone (Lambert conformal conic)
