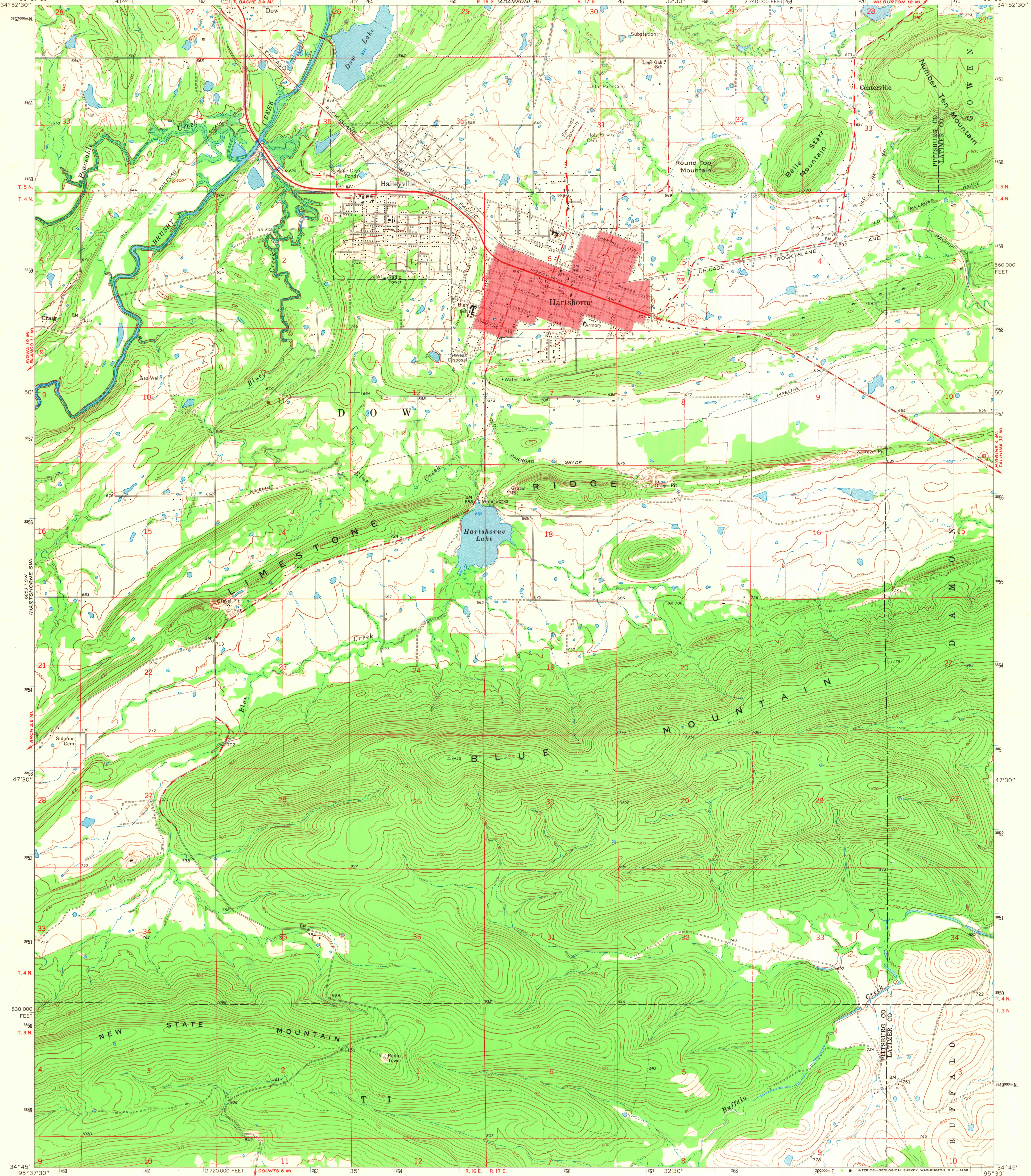

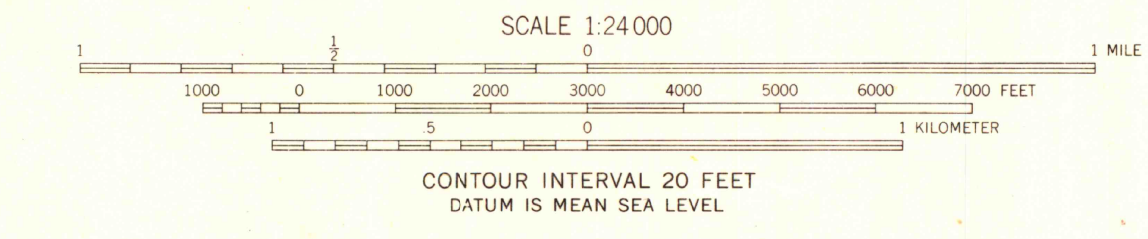
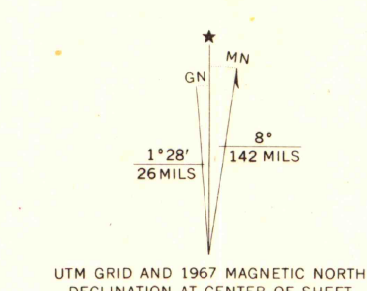

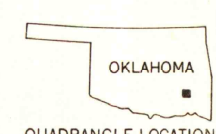
Red tint indicates area in which only landmark buildings are shown
