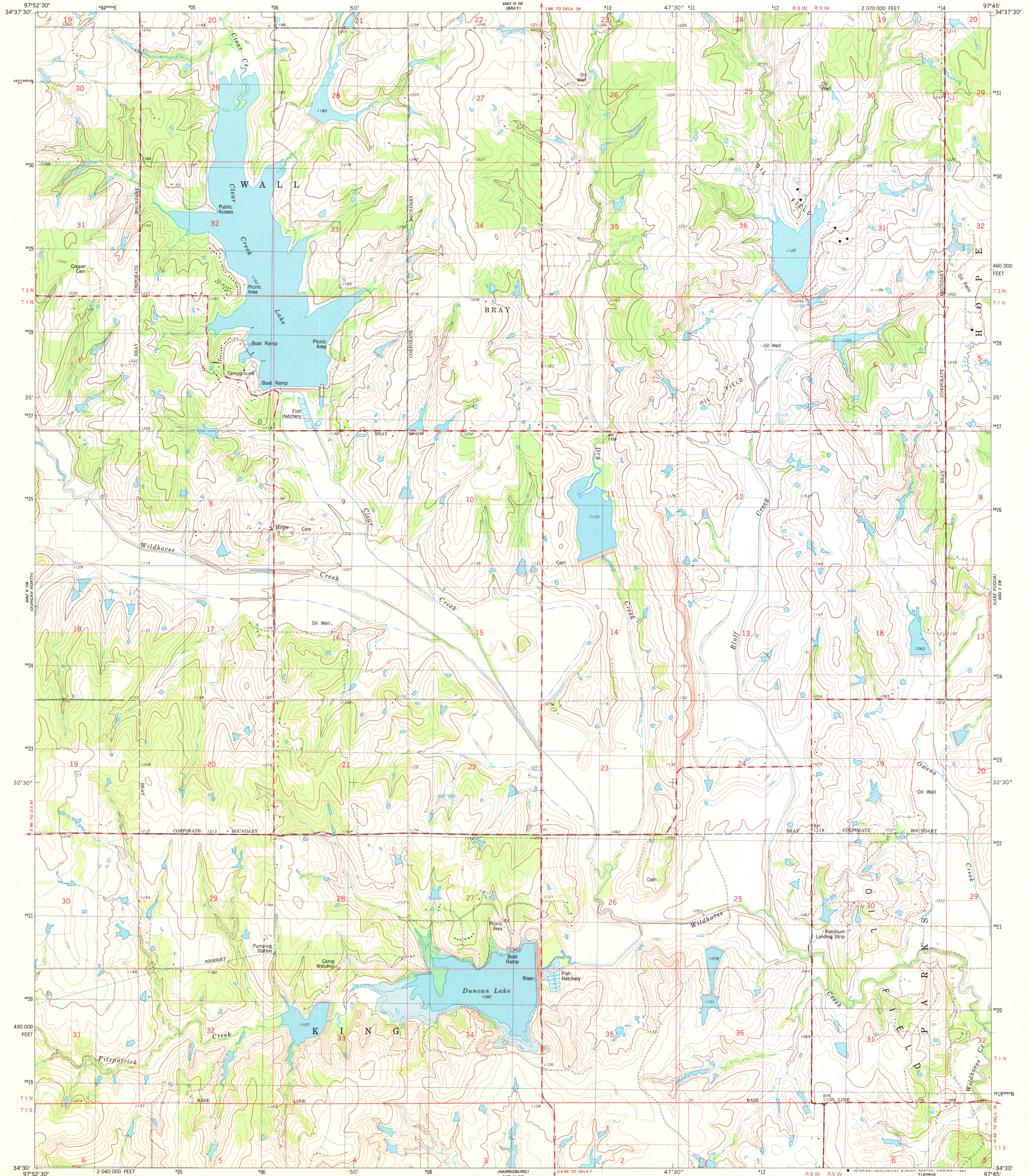

is subject to controlled inundation

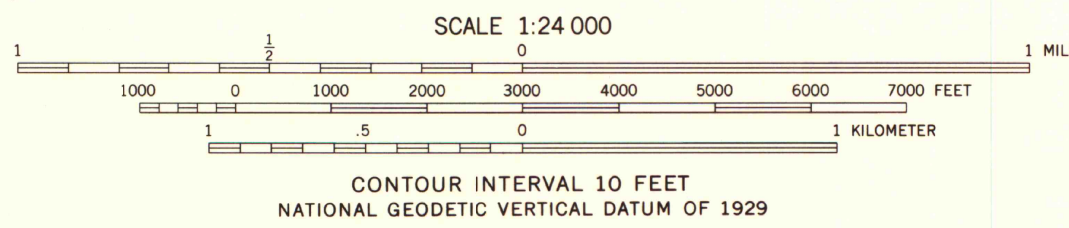
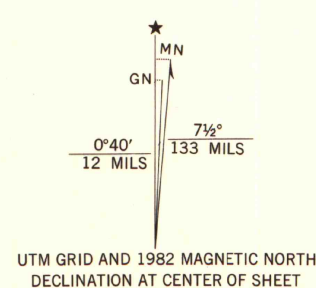
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983
