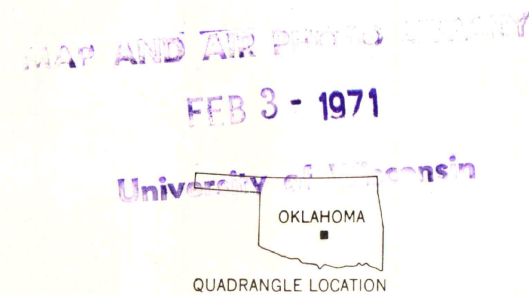
LITTLE AXE QUADRANGLE
