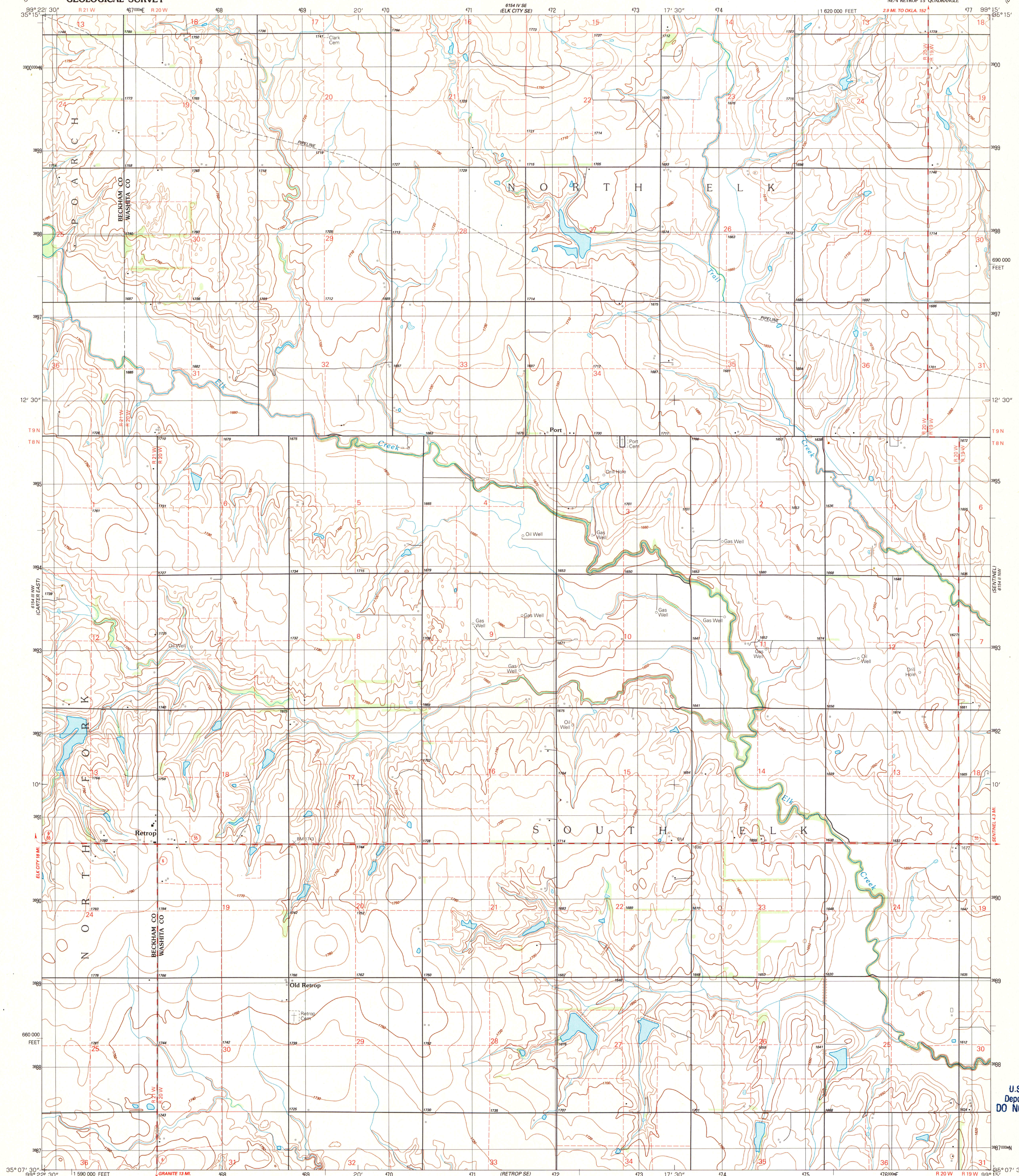

NE 1/4 RETROP 15' QUADRANGLE

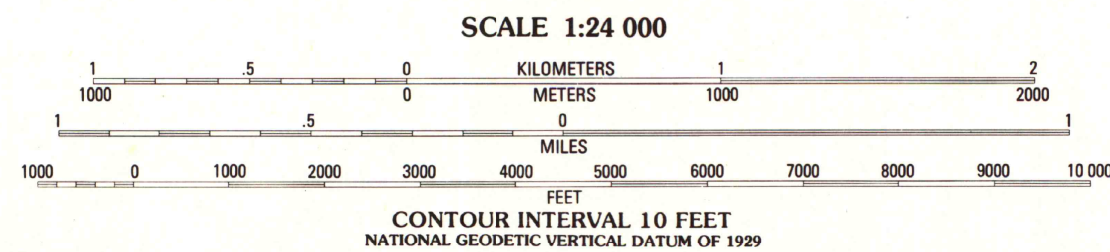
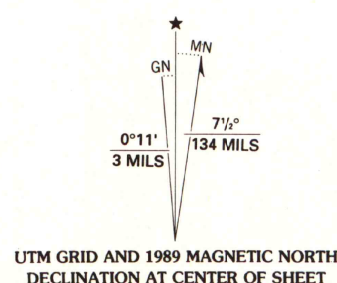

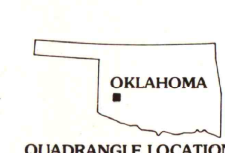

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983, move the projection lines 3 meters south and 33 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
