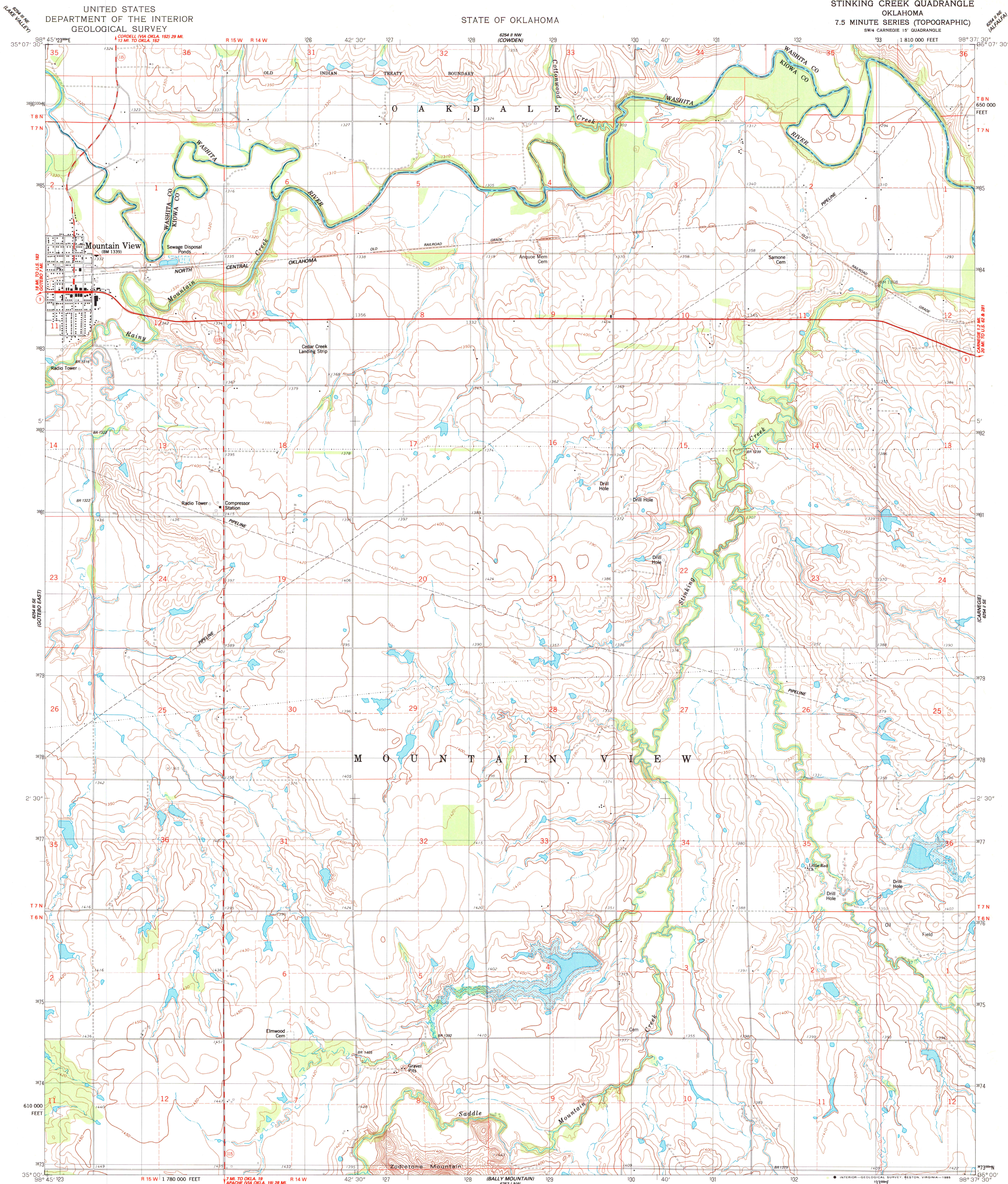


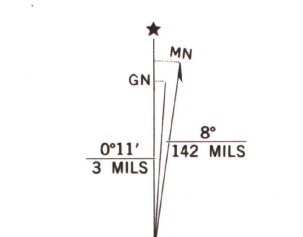

Projection and 10,000-foot grid ticks: Oklahoma coordinate system, south zone (Lambert conformal conic).
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid, zone 14.
1927 North American Datum.
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983, move the projection lines 4 meters south and 32 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks.
Areas covered by dashed light-blue pattern are subject to controlled inundation.
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked.
