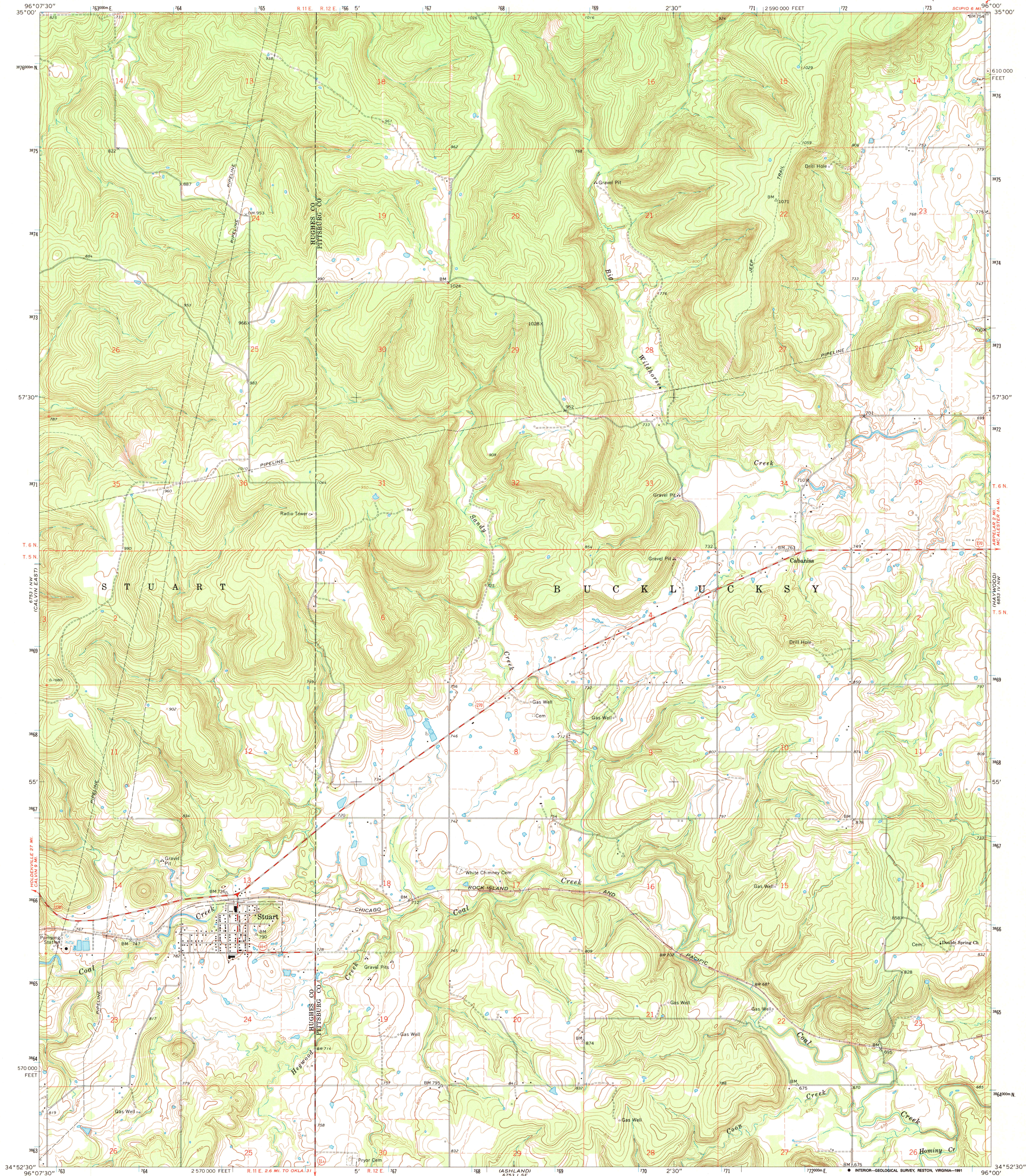

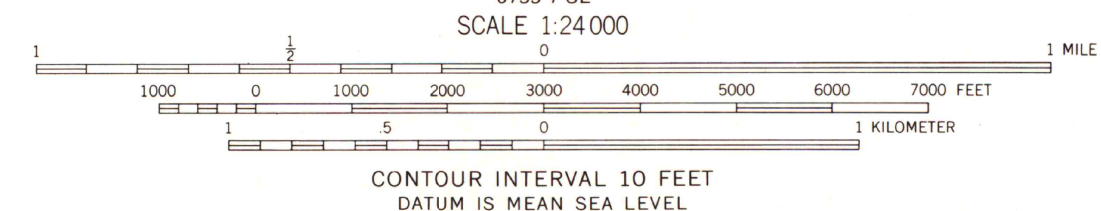
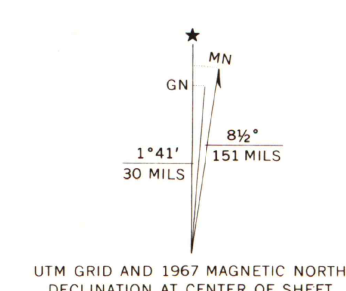
10,000-foot grid based on Oklahoma coordinate system, south zone.
